Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment. Ordinance 2020-505-E, adopting the 2021-2025 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to close out the completed Cuba Hunter Park Art in Public Places project (the "Cuba Hunter Park" project) and to transfer the remaining funds from the Cuba Hunter Park project to fund the Winton Drive Park Art in Public Places project and other future Art in Public Places projects (collectively, the "Projects").
