5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$20,408.00 FROM THE
6 COMPLETED CUBA HUNTER PARK ART IN PUBLIC
7 PLACES PROJECT TO TRANSFER \$5,000.00 TO THE
8 WINTON DRIVE PARK ART IN PUBLIC PLACES PROJECT
9 AND THE REMAINING \$15,408.00 TO THE ART IN
10 PUBLIC PLACES PROJECT ACCOUNT TO BE USED FOR
11 FUTURE ART IN PUBLIC PLACES PROJECTS, AS
12 INITIATED BY B.T. 21-065; PURPOSE OF
13 APPROPRIATION; AMENDING THE 2021-2025 FIVE-
14 YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN APPROVED BY
15 ORDINANCE 2020-505-E TO TRANSFER FUNDING TO
16 THE WINTON DRIVE PARK ART IN PUBLIC PLACES
17 PROJECT AND OTHER FUTURE ART IN PUBLIC PLACES
18 PROJECTS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

20 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

21 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2020-2021 fiscal year,
22 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the
23 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to
24 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):
25 (B.T. 21-065, attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and incorporated herein
26 by this reference)

31 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

1 The funding above represents an appropriation of funds
2 from the completed Cuba Hunter Park Public Art project in
3 the amount of \$20,408.00 and a transfer of \$5,000.00 to
4 the Winton Drive Park Art in Public Places project and
5 the remaining \$15,408.00 to the Art in Public Places
6 project account for future projects.

7 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
8 Section 1 is to transfer funds from the now complete Cuba Hunter
9 Park Art in Public Places project and a transfer of \$5,000.00 to
10 fund the Winton Drive Park Art in Public Places project with the
11 remaining \$15,408.00 being transferred to the Art in Public Places
12 project account for future Art in Public Places projects.

13 **Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment.** Ordinance
14 2020-505-E, adopting the 2021-2025 Five-Year Capital Improvement
15 Plan (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent
16 agencies, is hereby amended to close out the completed Cuba Hunter
17 Park Art in Public Places project (the "Cuba Hunter Park" project)
18 and to transfer the remaining funds from the Cuba Hunter Park
19 project to fund the Winton Drive Park Art in Public Places project
20 and other future Art in Public Places projects (collectively, the
21 "Projects"). The Projects are more fully described in the Project
22 Information Sheets attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated
23 herein by this reference. The City Council finds that the deferral
24 of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP
25 review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community
26 because such deferral will unnecessarily delay the Projects, which
27 are intended to bring art to areas of the community where it is
28 most needed.

1 Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*, enactment of
2 this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the
3 City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP
4 amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall
5 constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2020-505-E. In all other
6 respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by
7 Ordinance 2020-505-E shall remain unchanged and continue in full
8 force and effect.

9 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
10 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
11 without the Mayor's signature.
