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ORDINANCE 2021-157-E

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$900,938.27 ΙN FUNDS FROM SPECIAL EVENTS - FLORIDA GEORGIA GAME CONTINGENCY TO PROVIDE \$450,469.14 IN ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR PUBLIC SERVICE GRANTS IN THE 2021-2022 FISCAL YEAR AND \$450,469.13 IN ADDITIONAL FUNDING TO PUBLIC WORKS FOR SIDEWALKS; PROVIDING FOR CARRYOVER OF FUNDS; 2021-2025 FIVE-YEAR AMENDING THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2020-505-E TO INCREASE FUNDING FOR THE PROJECT TITLED "SIDEWALK/CURB CONSTRUCTION AND REPAIR; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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WHEREAS, the Public Service Grants are appropriated annually to be beneficial to the general welfare of the people of the City of Jacksonville and to their economic, social, medical, and educational improvements and advancement; and

WHEREAS, the Public Service Grant Committee has been established to review, evaluate and score each public service grant in accordance with the annual recommendation of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, although the public service grant appropriation over the years has remained relatively flat at approximately \$2.8 million dollars, the City Council appropriates through direct

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contracting without bid, 2-3 times that amount to social services and other organizations; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of Jacksonville, are evermore in need of social services; and

WHEREAS, arguably, the highest and best use for the funds for social services is through an open, transparent, and competitive process, by which the City Council establishes the most vulnerable populations and then allows the providers to competitively bid to provide the services requested, through an orderly and clearly delineated process as outlined in the Ordinance Code, as opposed to piecemealing funds to those who may be aware or have more familiarity with the legislative process; and

WHEREAS, another on-going concern for the citizens of Jacksonville is the condition of public sidewalks throughout the city and for the last many years the City Council has approved a budget for the Public Works Department which includes approximately \$3,000,000 for sidewalk repairs city-wide; and

WHEREAS, there continues to be a need each year for additional sidewalk repairs in excess of the budget-funded amount complaints regarding sidewalk disrepair is one of the most common concerns that Council Members hear from their constituents; and

WHEREAS, the repair of sidewalks is a community-wide concern and the Council finds that a portion of the remaining funding should be allocated to sidewalk repairs by amendment to the Public Works Department budget; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2020-2021 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(C) Explanation of Appropriation

> The funds above are being appropriated from Special Events - Florida Georgia Game Contingency to provide for \$450,469.14 in additional funding for Public Service Grants in the next fiscal year and \$450,469.13 in additional funding for sidewalks.

Purpose. The appropriation in Section 1 is to Section 2. provide for \$450,469.14 in additional funding for Public Service Grants in the 2021-2022 fiscal year and \$450,469.13 in additional funding for sidewalks.

Section 3. Carryover. The funds appropriated in ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year 2021-2022.

CIP Amendment and Findings. Ordinance 2020-Section 4. 505-E, being the 2021-2025 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to increase funding for the project entitled "Sidewalk/Curb Construction and Repair." This project is more fully described in the Project Information Sheet, attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference. This ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2020-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Program approved by Ordinance 2020-505-E shall continue in full force and effect. The Council finds that the deferral of this amendment until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best

interest of the community because there is an immediate need for 1 2 the construction and repair of sidewalks city-wide. By installation 3 of an alternative field type, the proposed synthetic turf field, it will allow for the City to maintain and preserve the existing grass 4 fields and provide an economical long-term solution. Pursuant to 5 Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, a vote on this ordinance shall 6 7 require the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the Council Members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in 8 9 this section.

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
