## ORDINANCE 2021-151-E

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$50,467.32 IN ANTICIPATED REVENUE FROM THE LEASE OF A PORTION OF CITY-OWNED PROPERTY LOCATED AT 7600 BAILEY BODY ROAD, JACKSONVILLE, FL 32216 TO THOMPSON ENTERPRISES OF JACKSONVILLE, LLC TO BE USED BY THE JACKSONVILLE FIRE AND RESCUE DEPARTMENT FOR THE PURCHASE OF CAPITAL FIREFIGHTING EQUIPMENT, AS INITIATED BY REVISED B.T. 21-039; PURPOSE OF APPROPRIATION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above represents an appropriation of \$50,467.32 in anticipated revenue from the lease of a portion of Cityowned property located at 7600 Bailey Body Road, Jacksonville, Florida 32216. The Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department will use these funds to purchase capital firefighting equipment.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to appropriate anticipated revenue generated from the lease of a portion of City-owned property located at 7600 Bailey Body Jacksonville, Florida 32216 to Thompson Enterprises of Jacksonville, Florida (the "Tenant") for a monthly rental amount of \$6,000.00 (the "Lease"). The City purchased the aforementioned property and surrounding parcels in December 2020 as the future location of the new Fire Station #65. The Lease was assigned to the City at the time of purchase and a copy of the Assignment of Lease, which includes copies of the Lease and First Amendment to Lease, has been placed On File with the Office of Legislative Services. funds appropriated hereunder represent the rent to be collected from the Tenant during the months of January 2021 through September 2021. The Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department will use these funds to purchase firefighting capital equipment including, but not limited to, thermal imaging cameras, airpacks, extrication equipment and other similar items.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
