The City Council approved Resolution 2019-844-A to support the construction of a new facility at 1632 Zoo Parkway to serve as a liquefied natural gas export facility.

The legislation approved a REV Grant based on an estimated \$542M in private capital investment and creation of 12 new jobs at an average wage of \$85,000 per year. This was a ten-year REV Grant (50% of the incremental increase in ad valorem taxes), capped at \$23,000,000. The Company must create at least 10 new jobs and invest a minimum of \$250M by the end of the performance schedule or the REV Grant would be terminated.

The Economic Development Agreement (EDA) dated January 22, 2020 required the Company to commence construction by June 30, 2020 and to complete construction of the infrastructure improvements by December 31, 2023. Amendment One to the EDA was signed on June 17, 2020. This technical amendment approved the following due to unanticipated construction delays resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic: 11 month extension to the construction commencement date, to May 31, 2021; 12 month extension to the construction completion date, to December 31, 2024; and 12 month extension to the job creation deadline, to December 31, 2024.
