9 DEPARTMENT, MUNICIPAL CODE COMPLIANCE DIVISION,  
10 AND THE BALANCE OF \$2,269,912.57 TO THE PUBLIC  
11 WORKS DEPARTMENT, MOWING AND LANDSCAPE  
12 MAINTENANCE DIVISION TO BE SPLIT BETWEEN MOWING  
13 AND LANDSCAPE - PRIVATE PROPERTY (\$1,361,947.00)  
14 AND MOWING AND LANDSCAPE - TREE REMOVAL  
15 (\$907,965.57), TO PROCURE NUISANCE ABATEMENT  
16 CONTRACTUAL SERVICES FOR THE REMOVAL OF PROPERTY  
17 CODE VIOLATIONS THROUGHOUT THE CITY IN  
18 COMPLIANCE WITH CHAPTER 518, *ORDINANCE CODE*, AS  
19 INITIATED BY B.T. 21-066; PURPOSE OF  
20 APPROPRIATION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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22 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

23 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2020-2021 fiscal year,  
24 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated  
25 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)  
26 listed in subsection (b):

2 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

3 The funding above comprises available revenues from the  
4 Nuisance Abatement Lien Special Revenue Fund pursuant to  
5 Section 111.470, *Ordinance Code*, that will be used for  
6 nuisance abatement contractual services.

7 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
8 Section 1 is to provide funding for nuisance abatement contractual  
9 services for the removal of property code violations throughout the  
10 city in accordance with Chapter 518, *Ordinance Code*. A total of  
11 \$2,180,896.39 is allocated to the Neighborhoods Department, Municipal  
12 Code Compliance Division, and the remaining \$2,269,912.57 is  
13 allocated to the Public Works Department, Mowing and Landscape  
14 Maintenance Division to be split between Mowing and Landscape -  
15 Private Property (\$1,361,947.00) and Mowing and Landscape - Tree  
16 Removal (\$907,965.57), for the procurement of these contractual  
17 services.

18 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall  
19 become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming  
20 effective without the Mayor's signature.
