4 **ORDINANCE 2021-251**

5 AN ORDINANCE REGARDING THE DUVAL COUNTY PROPERTY
6 APPRAISER'S BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022;
7 ADOPTING RECOMMENDED FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS
8 FOR THE DUVAL COUNTY PROPERTY APPRAISER'S 2021-
9 2022 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
10 DATE.

12 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 195.087, *Florida Statutes*, the
13 Duval County Property Appraiser's Office ("Property Appraiser")
14 submits its budget annually to the Department of Revenue on or before
15 June 1; and

16 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 106.201, *Ordinance Code*, the Mayor
17 is required to submit the final annual Consolidated City of
18 Jacksonville budget proposal, which includes the Property Appraiser's
19 budget, to the City Council no later than July 15 annually; and

20 **WHEREAS**, during the weeks following July 15, the City Council
21 Finance Committee reviews the budgets of the Property Appraiser along
22 with the entire consolidated government as is required by the Charter
23 Section 5.07; and

24 **WHEREAS**, therefore the review of the Property Appraiser's budget
25 is simultaneously occurring with Department of Revenue and the City
26 of Jacksonville; and

27 **WHEREAS**, although there is a provision for the Department of
28 Revenue to include the City of Jacksonville's modifications to the
29 Property Appraiser's budget, that information must be received from
30 the City Council, acting as the whole Council, prior to the Florida
31 Department of Revenue tentatively approving the Property Appraiser's

1 budget or alternatively subject to an appeal process; and

2 **WHEREAS**, the City Council recognizes this schedule and desires
3 to review the Property Appraiser's budget as will be presented to the
4 Department of Revenue in advance of the Mayor's annual budget
5 proposal; now therefore

6 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council for the City of Jacksonville:

7 **Section 1. Property Appraiser's Budget Review.** The City
8 Council is in receipt of the Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Property
9 Appraiser's budget which is attached hereto as **Exhibit 1**.

10 **Section 2. Adoption of recommended findings and**
11 **conclusions.** The Council has reviewed the Property Appraiser's budget
12 along with the input and recommendations from the Finance and
13 Administration Department and Chief Administrative Officer of the
14 Mayor. The recommended findings and conclusions are hereby adopted
15 and shall be forwarded to the Department of Revenue to be considered
16 by same in tentatively approving the Duval County Property Appraiser's
17 2021-2022 fiscal year budget.

18 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
19 effective upon the signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
20 without the Mayor's signature.
