AN ORDINANCE CONFIRMING THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT OF CHRISTOPHER WALKER, A ST. JOHNS COUNTY RESIDENT WITH SUBSTANTIAL BUSINESS INTEREST IN DUVAL COUNTY, TO THE JACKSONVILLE HOUSING AUTHORITY, FILLING A SEAT FORMERLY JONATHAN A. MCGOWAN, HELD ΒY PURSUANT ΤO CHAPTER 51A, ORDINANCE CODE, FOR A PARTIAL TERM TO EXPIRE SEPTEMBER 16, 2021, FOLLOWED BY A FIRST FULL TERM TO EXPIRE SEPTEMBER 16, 2025; PROVIDING FOR A NON-RESIDENT OF DUVAL WITH SUBSTANTIAL ECONOMIC COUNTY BUSINESS SEATED ON THE JACKSONVILLE INTEREST TO BE HOUSING AUTHORITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Confirmation. The Council hereby confirms the Mayor's appointment of Christopher Walker, a St. Johns County Resident with substantial business interest in Duval County, to the Jacksonville Housing Authority, filling a seat formerly held by Jonathan A. McGowan, pursuant to Chapter 51A, Ordinance Code, for a partial term to expire September 16, 2021, followed by a first full term to expire September 16, 2025.

28 Section 2. A Non-Resident of Duval County with 29 substantial economic business interests in Duval County. Section 30 50.102 (Members of boards and commissions), Ordinance Code, 31 requires Board and Commission members be either a Duval County

resident or individuals with substantial economic business 1 or 2 philanthropic interests in Duval County. Mr. Walker has substantial 3 business interests in Duval County. Christopher Walker is the Partner in Charge and equity partner/owner in Lippes Mathias, which 4 5 is based in Duval County. Since 2017, Lippes Mathias has grown from 3 employees to over 40 full time employees, the majority of whom 6 7 live in Duval County. Mr. Walker represents numerous individuals and businesses in Duval county and actively works to bring third 8 9 party businesses and investments into Duval County.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
