AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING ATLANTIC COAST LINE 6 7 LOCOMOTIVE NO. 1504, LOCATED AT 1000 WEST BAY 8 STREET AND SITUATED ON THE GROUNDS OF THE 9 PRIME OSBORN CONVENTION CENTER, IN COUNCIL 9, JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA 10 DISTRICT ("ACL 1504"); DECLARING ACL 1504, VALUED 11 ΑT \$50,000.00, TO BE SURPLUS TO THE NEEDS OF THE 12 13 CITY OF JACKSONVILLE (THE "CITY") AND AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO 14 15 TRANSFER TITLE OF SAID PROPERTY TO THE NORTH FLORIDA CHAPTER OF THE NATIONAL RAILWAY 16 HISTORICAL SOCIETY, INC. ("NFC-NRHS"), AT NO 17 18 COST, IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 122.812(C), ORDINANCE CODE, FOR RESTORATION AND OPERATION 19 20 AS A SHORT-LINE PASSENGER EXCURSION AND FUNDRAISING TRAIN; DESIGNATING THE PLANNING 21 22 AND DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT TO MONITOR ACTUAL 23 USE OF ACL 1504; PROVIDING FOR A REVERTER; 24 AUTHORIZING REMOVAL OF THE NATIONAL REGISTER 25 HISTORIC PLACES DESIGNATION; RESCINDING OF LOCAL LANDMARK AND LANDMARK SITE DESIGNATIONS 26 FOR ACL 1504, WAIVING THE REQUIREMENTS OF 27 307, ORDINANCE CODE, RELATIVE 2.8 CHAPTER ТΟ 29 REVIEW OF THE RESCISSION OF THE LOCAL LANDMARK 30 AND LANDMARK SITE DESIGNATIONS BY THE JACKSONVILLE HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION 31

AND TO THE EXTENT SAID CHAPTER IS INCONSISTENT WITH THIS ORDINANCE, AND DIRECTING THE ZONING ADMINISTRATOR AND CHIEF OF LEGISLATIVE SERVICES TO TAKE CERTAIN ACTIONS RELATIVE TO THE RESCISSION OF LOCAL LANDMARK AND LANDMARK SITE DESIGNATIONS FOR ACL 1504; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

10 Section 1. Declaration of Surplus. The City hereby declares ACL 1504, valued at \$50,000.00, as more particularly 11 described in **Exhibit 1**, attached hereto and incorporated herein by 12 13 this reference, to be surplus to the needs of the City of Jacksonville and authorizes the appropriate City officials 14 to 15 transfer title of ACL 1504 to North Florida Chapter of the National Railway Historical Society, Inc., at no cost, pursuant to Section 16 17 122.812(c), Ordinance Code. A copy of the certificate from the Director of Procurement certifying compliance with the provisions 18 19 of Chapter 122, Ordinance Code, is attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and 20 incorporated herein by this reference. A copy of the property 21 transfer form is attached hereto as Exhibit 3.

22 is under contract Section 2. Public Purpose. NFC-NRHS 23 with Sugar Express, LLC ("Sugar Express"), who will restore and 24 operate ACL 1504 as a "fundraising" train by using the locomotive 25 to offer short-line passenger excursions in south central Florida. 26 NFC-NRHS will use the proceeds of the sale of ACL 1504 to Sugar 27 Express to fund a "NFC-NRHS/Sugar Express Railroad Educational 28 Scholarship" (the "Scholarship") to provide financial assistance to 29 local Duval County high school students who desire to attend the National Railway Historical Society Rail Camp and other related 30 activities. In addition, a portion of the sale proceeds will be 31

used to support local educational and historical preservation goals of NFC-NRHS. Once ACL 1504 is operational, Sugar Express has agreed that all ticket sale proceeds generated from the first year of operations will go to NFC-NRHS for furtherance of rail preservation projects and further endowment of the Scholarship fund.

7 Section 3. Planning and Development Department to Monitor 8 Actual Use of ACL 1504. The Planning and Development Department 9 will be the designated agency to monitor the use and operation of 10 ACL 1504 in accordance with the purposes set forth herein.

Section 4. The disposition authorized herein 11 Reverter. 12 is conditioned upon the refurbishment and continued use and operation of ACL 1504 for the purposes set forth herein and is 13 14 further conditioned upon NFC-NRHS agreeing to convey and physically 15 return ACL 1504 back to the City, at no cost to the City, in the event ACL 1504 is not refurbished and continuously used for these 16 17 NCF-NRHS shall include this reverter in any and all purposes. documents effectuating a sale or transfer of ownership of ACL 1504 18 19 for the sole and express benefit of the City of Jacksonville.

20 Section 5. Authorizing Removal of National Register of 21 Historic Places Designation. The City Council hereby recognizes 22 and authorizes the removal of the National Register of Historic 23 Places designation that will be automatically revoked upon transfer 24 of ACL 1504 from its current location.

25 Rescinding Local Landmark and Landmark Site Section 6. Designations; Waiver of Chapter 307, Ordinance Code, Pertaining to 26 27 Review by the Jacksonville Historic Preservation Commission; 28 Directing the Zoning Administrator and Chief of Legislative 29 Services to Take Certain Actions. The City Council hereby rescinds 30 the Local Landmark and Landmark Site Designations for Atlantic Coast Line Locomotive No. 1504, located at 1000 West Bay Street and 31

situated on the grounds of the Prime Osborn Convention Center, as
 approved by Ordinance 2009-650-E, and states and finds as follows:

3 (a) The Planning and Development Department has reviewed the
4 application to rescind the Local Landmark and Landmark Site
5 Designations for ACL 1504, as approved by Ordinance 2009-650-E, and
6 has made its recommendation to the City Council.

7 The Land Use and Zoning Committee, after due notice and (b) public hearing, reviewed the application to rescind the Local 8 9 Landmark and Landmark Site Designations for ACL 1504, as approved 10 by Ordinance 2009-650-E, and has made its recommendations to the City Council. Pursuant to Council Rule 6.105, there shall be only 11 12 one official record of the quasi-judicial proceedings before the Committee of Reference, and the City Council finds that the Land 13 Use and Zoning Committee served as the Committee creating the 14 15 official record of quasi-judicial proceedings for this matter, notwithstanding review of this Ordinance by other Committees of the 16 17 City Council.

(c) Based upon the competent, substantial evidence in the 18 record, including the Staff Report of the Planning and Development 19 Department and the recommendation of the Land Use and Zoning 20 21 Committee, the City Council hereby finds that ACL 1504 fails to 22 meet the requisite number of criteria for Local Landmark and 23 Landmark Site Designations pursuant Section 307.104(j), to 24 Ordinance Code, without owner consent.

(d) The City Council hereby waives Chapter 307, Ordinance Code, to the extent inconsistent with this Ordinance, including review by the Jacksonville Historic Preservation Commission, to expedite transfer and ultimate restoration of ACL 1504, and finds that the notice provided, and public hearings held, by the City Council and the Land Use and Zoning Committee meet all procedural and substantive due process requirements for rescinding the Local

Landmark and Landmark Site Designations as described herein.
 Pursuant to the Rules of the City Council, the Rules Committee of
 the Council reviewed this waiver and has made its recommendations
 to the City Council.

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(e) The City Council hereby directs the following actions:

(i) The Zoning Administrator shall remove the designations of ACL 1504 as a Local Landmark and Landmark Site on the City's Zoning Atlas.

9 (ii) The Chief of Legislative Services shall notify each 10 applicant, the property owner, and the Property Appraiser, of 11 the rescission of the designations of ACL 1504 as a Local 12 Landmark and Landmark Site.

(iii) The Chief of Legislative Services shall record this Ordinance in the public records of Duval County, Florida.

(f) The enactment of this Section 6 of this Ordinance shall be deemed to constitute a quasi-judicial action of the City Council. Its effective date shall be the date of signature by the Council President and Council Secretary, notwithstanding the date of signature by the Mayor, or this Ordinance becoming law without the Mayor's signature.

21 Section 7. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become 22 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 23 without the Mayor's signature.
