Bill Summary: The bill allocates \$69,385.00 In grant funds from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services HIV Emergency Relief Project Grant to fund a new position within the Social Services Division of the Department of Parks, Recreation and Community Services, as initiated by B.T. 21-068; and authorizes the position, as initiated by R.C. 21-100

Background Information: The funding was initially appropriated pursuant to Ordinance 2020-504-E for the Ryan White HIV/Aids Program to fund a new Data and Quality Coordinator/SPE position with no local match required. The appropriation provides for an in-house position within the Social Services Division instead of an outside contractor. The full-time Data and Quality Coordinator/SPE will be responsible for assessing the City's coordination, monitoring, and oversight of the HIV-related health and support services provided through the Program to persons living with HIV/AIDS residing in the Jacksonville Transitional Grant Area.

Policy Impact Area: Ryan White HIV/Aids Program, Jacksonville Transitional Grant Area

Fiscal Impact: The appropriation of \$69,385.00, as initiated by B.T. 21-068.
