Type of Action: Appropriation

Bill Summary: The ordinance appropriates \$14,247.75 of funding for the installation of a relocated public sidewalk on property owned by the Duval County School Board along Carlisle Road.

Background Information: The appropriation goes towards site preparation, mobilization, tree removal, a concrete sidewalk, and clearing of the site which is outlined in Exhibit 2. The provisions of Section 106.315, Ordinance 24 Code, requiring that bond funds be used on City property is waived. The existing public sidewalk on Carlisle Road is located on property which is owned by the Duval County School Board; to address a public safety concern made by the John N.C. Stockton Elementary School, the City will pay the costs to relocate the existing sidewalk on Duval County School Board property and the Duval County School Board will thereafter maintain the sidewalk. The relocated sidewalk will remain open to the public.
