ORDINANCE 2021-320

AN ORDINANCE REGARDING CHAPTER 307 (HISTORIC PRESERVATION), ORDINANCE CODE; AMENDING THE LANDMARK DESIGNATION OF 325 EAST DUVAL STREET, THE YWCA BUILDING, OWNED BY VC CATHEDRAL, LLC, NUMBER 073617-0020, ESTATE ΙN DISTRICT 7, JACKSONVILLE FLORIDA, DIRECTING THE CHIEF OF LEGISLATIVE SERVICES TO NOTIFY APPLICANT, THE PROPERTY OWNER, AND THE PROPERTY APPRAISER OF THE LANDMARK DESIGNATION, AND TO RECORD THE LANDMARK DESIGNATION IN THE OFFICIAL RECORDS OF DUVAL COUNTY; DIRECTING THE ZONING ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER THE LANDMARK DESIGNATION ON THE ZONING ATLAS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Jacksonville City Council ("Council") enacted Chapter 307 (Historic Preservation), Ordinance Code, to facilitate the designation of landmarks and amending landmarks, where appropriate; and

whereas, the YWCA building located at 325 East Duval Street was constructed in 1949 and consists of an "L" shaped portion, which fronts on the northeast corner of East Duval Street and Shields Place and a rear, flat-roof portion facing a parking lot on the interior of the block; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance 2017-436-E, the "L" shaped portion was designated a local landmark at the request of the

WHEREAS, the current owner, VC Cathedral, LLC, has requested the landmark designation be amended to include the rear, flat-roof portion of the YWCA building (the "Third Wing"), located at 325 East Duval Street, Real Estate Number 073617-0020, in Council District 7; and

WHEREAS, the Third Wing is part of the original 1949 building constructed of materials and basic design features compatible with the "L" shaped portion; and

WHEREAS, in approximately 1949, the three-story Colonial Revival style building was designed to house the Young Woman's Christian Association, which provided permanent and transient accommodations and services for young single women living and working in Jacksonville; and

WHEREAS, the YWCA building was designed by architect Jefferson Davis Powell and constructed by Owen Preston Woodcock both masters in their fields and identified as influencers of the development of the City of Jacksonville; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the requirements of Chapter 307 (Historic Preservation), Ordinance Code, the Council has considered the issue of amending the landmark designation to include the Third Wing, taking into consideration its importance and historical value, as more fully set forth in the Designation Application, LM-21-03, and Staff Report of the Historic Preservation Section of the Planning and Development Department, a copy of which is on file with Legislative Services as Composite 1, and incorporated by reference herein (the "Application and Staff Report"); and

WHEREAS, all public notice and public hearing requirements have been met for amending the landmark designation; and

WHEREAS, on April 28, 2021, the Jacksonville Historic Preservation Commission reviewed and recommended approval of

amending the landmark designation (the transcript of the Jacksonville Historic Preservation Commission is **on file** as **Composite 2**); and

WHEREAS, the property owner is in support of the landmark designation; and

WHEREAS, having met the requisite criteria, the Council finds that it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Jacksonville to amend the local landmark designation of 325 East Duval Street to include the Third Wing of the YWCA building as a local landmark, in furtherance of historic preservation and protection; now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Amending of Local Landmark. Pursuant to Chapter 307 (Historic Preservation), Ordinance Code, the Council hereby amends the local landmark designation of the YWCA building located at 325 East Duval Street, Real Estate Number 073617-0020, in Council District 7, to include the Third Wing as a local landmark.

Section 2. Satisfaction of Requisite Criteria. The Council hereby finds that the YWCA building meets four (4) of the requisite criteria set forth in Section 307.104(j), Ordinance Code, as more fully set forth in the Application and Staff Report.

Section 3. Notice of Landmark Designation. Pursuant to Section 307.104(m), Ordinance Code, the Council hereby directs the Chief of Legislative Services, as designee of the Council Secretary, to notify the applicant, the property owner, and the Property Appraiser of the designation of the landmark.

Section 4. Recording of Landmark Designation. The Council hereby directs the Chief of Legislative Services to record this ordinance in the official records for Duval County, Florida.

Section 5. Landmark Designation on Zoning Atlas.

Pursuant to Section 307.104(n), Ordinance Code, the Council hereby directs the Zoning Administrator, as designee of the Director of the Planning and Development Department, to enter the local landmark designation on the Zoning Atlas, in accordance with Section 656.203, Ordinance Code.

Section 6. Effective Date. The enactment of this ordinance shall be deemed to constitute a quasi-judicial action of the Council and therefore shall become effective upon signature by the Council President and Council Secretary.
