9 SERVICES FOR ADDITIONAL PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT

16 **Section 1.** For the 2020-2021 fiscal year, within the  
17 City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s)

27 The appropriation above provides \$98,848 in funding from  
28 the Social Justice and Community Investment Special  
29 Committee Contingency account to Department of Parks,  
30 Recreation and Community Services for new playground  
31 equipment at the Mary Lena Gibbs Community Center.

1           **Section 2.           Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
2 Section 1 is to provide funding for to the Department of Parks,  
3 Recreation and Community Services for additional playground  
4 equipment at the Mary Lena Gibbs Community Center, located at 6974  
5 Wilson Blvd., in Council District 10, as more particularly  
6 described in **Exhibit 2** attached hereto.

7           **Section 3.           Procurement Directive.** Prior to the  
8 expenditure of any funds contemplated herein, the Department of  
9 Parks, Recreation and Community Services shall obtain an  
10 administrative award or purchasing tool from the Procurement  
11 Division for the purchase amount not to exceed \$98,848 for the  
12 playscape.

13           **Section 4.           Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become  
14 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
15 without the Mayor's signature.
