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The Florida Housing Finance 6 Section 2. Purpose. 7 Corporation provides funding to local governments as an incentive to create partnerships that produce and preserve affordable 8 9 homeownership and multifamily housing. The SHIP program was 10 designed to serve very low, low, and moderate-income families. SHIP funds may be used for emergency repairs, new construction, 11 rehabilitation, down payment and closing costs assistance, impact 12 13 fees, construction and gap financing, mortgage buy-downs, acquisition of property for affordable housing, matching dollars 14 for federal housing grants and programs, and homeownership 15 counseling. The Schedule of Proposed Funding detailing the proposed 16 uses of the SHIP funds is attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and 17 18 incorporated herein by this reference. A copy of the state of 19 Florida Projected SHIP Estimates for Fiscal Year 2021-2022 is attached hereto as Exhibit 3. 20
