In addition, jurisdictions must match every dollar of HOME funds used (except for administrative costs) with 25 cents from non-federal sources, which may include donated materials or labor, the value of donated property, proceeds from bond financing, and other resources. The City meets this match requirement by utilizing State Housing Initiative Partnership (SHIP) funds for activities and recipients that are eligible under the HOME program.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funding for a wide range of housing assistance activities for eligible low- and very low-income individuals and families including building, buying, and/or rehabilitating affordable housing for rent or homeownership, or providing direct rental and other assistance to tenants and homebuyers. The HOME funds will be used for the City's Limited Repair Program, development subsidies for certified Community Housing Development Organizations (CHDOs), and a revolving loan fund for development of affordable housing. These funds will also cover the City's costs for administration and delivery of the HOME The Schedule of Proposed Funding detailing the proposed use of HOME funds is attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this reference. A copy of the HUD grant award letter is attached hereto as Exhibit 3.

Section 3. Approval of Positions. There are hereby approved the positions more fully described in R.C. 22-003, attached hereto as Exhibit 4 and incorporated herein by this

2	and will provide services in support of the HOME program.
