10 *CODE*, ALLOCATING \$1,896,350.49 TO THE
11 NEIGHBORHOODS DEPARTMENT, MUNICIPAL CODE
12 COMPLIANCE DIVISION, AND THE BALANCE OF
13 \$1,973,752.55 TO THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT,
14 MOWING AND LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE DIVISION TO
15 BE SPLIT BETWEEN MOWING AND LANDSCAPE -
16 PRIVATE PROPERTY (\$1,183,822.06) AND MOWING
17 AND LANDSCAPE - TREE REMOVAL (\$789,930.49), TO
18 PROCURE NUISANCE ABATEMENT CONTRACTUAL
19 SERVICES FOR THE REMOVAL OF PROPERTY CODE
20 VIOLATIONS THROUGHOUT THE CITY IN COMPLIANCE
21 WITH CHAPTER 518, *ORDINANCE CODE*, AS INITIATED
22 BY REVISED B.T. 21-066; PURPOSE OF
23 APPROPRIATION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

25 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

26 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2020-2021 fiscal year,
27 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the
28 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to
29 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

1 as "Revised Exhibit 1, Revised B.T. 21-066, June 1, 2021 - NCSPHS"
2 and incorporated herein by this reference)

7 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

8 The funding above comprises available revenues from the
9 Nuisance Abatement Lien Special Revenue Fund pursuant to
10 Section 111.470, *Ordinance Code*, that will be used for
11 nuisance abatement contractual services.

12 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
13 Section 1 is to provide funding for nuisance abatement contractual
14 services for the removal of property code violations throughout the
15 city in accordance with Chapter 518, *Ordinance Code*. A total of
16 \$1,896,350.49 is allocated to the Neighborhoods Department,
17 Municipal Code Compliance Division, and the remaining \$1,973,752.55
18 is allocated to the Public Works Department, Mowing and Landscape
19 Maintenance Division to be split between Mowing and Landscape -
20 Private Property (\$1,183,822.06) and Mowing and Landscape - Tree
21 Removal (\$789,930.49), for the procurement of these contractual
22 services.

23 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall
24 become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming
25 effective without the Mayor's signature.
