AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$100,000 FROM THE SOCIAL JUSTICE AND COMMUNITY INVESTMENT SPECIAL COMMITTEE CONTINGENCY FOR THE OPERATION BOOST! PROGRAM (\$50,000 TO WORKFORCE INDUSTRIAL TRAINING, LLC ("WIT") AND \$50,000 FLORIDA STATE COLLEGE AT JACKSONVILLE ("FSCJ"); APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, A FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND WORKFORCE INDUSTRIAL TRAINING, LLC; INVOKING THE EXCEPTION SECTION 126.107(G), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW DIRECT CONTRACT WITH WORKFORCE INDUSTRIAL TRAINING, LLC TO PROVIDE THE SERVICES FOR OPERATION BOOST!; APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, A FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND FLORIDA STATE COLLEGE AT JACKSONVILLE; INVOKING THE EXCEPTION ΙN SECTION 126.107(G), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW DIRECT CONTRACT WITH FLORIDA STATE COLLEGE AT

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JACKSONVILLE TO PROVIDE SERVICES FOR OPERATION BOOST!; WAIVING SECTION 110.112 (ADVANCE OF CITY FUNDS; PROHIBITION AGAINST), PART 1 (THE CITY TREASURY), CHAPTER 110 (CITY TREASURY), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW FOR A PARTIAL ADVANCE PAYMENT BY THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE OFFICE OF GRANTS AND CONTRACT COMPLIANCE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2021-23-E appropriated \$200,000 for the Operation Boost! Program; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2020-2021 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

- (c) Explanation of Appropriation The funding above is being appropriated from the Social Justice and Community Investment Special Committee Contingency and to be utilized by WIT and FSCJ for the Operation Boost! program.
- Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide an additional \$100,000 in funding for the Operation Boost! program. The Operation Boost! program will provide

recruitment, training and employment assistance to low-income students and students who face barriers to employment. \$50,000 in additional funding will be used by WIT to provide cost free training to students who face barriers to employment and recidivism. \$50,000 in additional funding will be used by FSCJ to create scholarships for low-income students.

Section 3. Agreement approved and execution authorized. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, the First Amendment to the Funding Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and Workforce Industrial Training, LLC, in substantially the form as attached hereto as Exhibit 3, and incorporated herein by this reference (the "Agreement").

Section 4. Invoking the exception to Section 126.107(g), Ordinance Code. The City is hereby authorized to procure the use of the professional services of Workforce Industrial Training, LLC, to provide services for the Operation Boost! program. Pursuant to Section 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code, such procurement is exempted from competitive solicitation because the supplies or services are to be provided by those specifically prescribed within authorizing legislation that appropriates the same. With the exception of the foregoing, all other provisions of Chapter 126, Ordinance Code, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. Agreement approved and execution authorized. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, the First Amendment to the Funding Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and Florida State College at Jacksonville, in substantially the form as attached hereto as Revised Exhibit 2,

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labeled as "Revised Exhibit 2, Revised 1st Amd, June 2, 2021 -Finance", and incorporated herein by this reference "Agreement") to provide services for the Operation Boost! program.

Section 6. Invoking the exception to Section 126.107(g), Ordinance Code. The City is hereby authorized to procure the use of the professional services of Florida State College of Jacksonville to provide services for the Operation Boost! program. Pursuant to Section 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code, such procurement is exempted from competitive solicitation because the supplies or services are to be provided by those specifically prescribed within authorizing legislation that appropriates the same. With the exception of the foregoing, all other provisions of Chapter 126, Ordinance Code, shall remain in full force and effect.

Waiving Section 110.112, Ordinance Section 7. Section 110.112 (Advance of City funds; prohibition against), Part 1 (The City Treasury), Chapter 110 (City Treasury), Ordinance Code, is hereby waived to allow for a partial advance payment as described in the Agreements.

Oversight. The Mayor is requested to appoint Section 8. the Office of Grants and Contract Compliance to oversee the project in Section 2 above and to ensure compliance with all other appropriate laws.

Section 9. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
