Bill Summary: This bill is an appropriation of \$600,000 from de-appropriated citywide capital projects to be transferred to the Lower Eastside Drainage project. The 2021-2025 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan is amended to provide for the transfer of funds for this project.

Background Information: The purpose of this legislation is to provide funds for the Lower Eastside Drainage project. This appropriation is necessary to fund reconciliation of quantities and field adjustments at the completion of the Project which includes design, permitting, right of-way acquisition and construction of drainage improvements for flood reduction in the area bounded by Spearing Street on the west, 7th Street on the north, Martin Luther King Drive on the east, and 1st Street on the south.

Fiscal Impact: Appropriation of \$600,000 in existing dollars, no additional debt to the City
