Bill Summary: This bill confirms the Mayor's appointment of Chester Spellman, as a member of the Public Service Grant Council, replacing Carol Brock, for a partial term ending December 31, 2022.

Background Information: The Public Service Grant Council is established pursuant to Chapter 80, Ordinance Code, and charged with the review and evaluation of all Public Service Grant applications and responsibility for making funding recommendations to the Mayor and City Council for Public Service Grants. Section 80.102, Ordinance Code, provides the Public Service Grant Council shall consist of 15 voting members, eight of whom shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by City Council and seven of whom shall be appointed by the City Council President and confirmed by City Council.

Mr. Spellman is the Director of AmeriCorps State and National and was appointed by the White House on August 1, 2017. Mr. Spellman earned his master's degree in organizational leadership from Regent University. Mr. Spellman resides in Duval County.
