A RESOLUTION HONORING AND COMMENDING 7-YEAR-OLD CHASE POUST ON HIS QUICK THINKING AND IN FACILITATING THE RESCUE BRAVERY FATHER AND SISTER FROM A POTENTIAL TRAGEDY IN THE ST. JOHNS RIVER; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on the Friday of Memorial Day weekend 2021, Steven Poust and his son Chase, age 7, and daughter Abigail, age 4, were enjoying a boating outing on the St. Johns River near Mandarin Point; and

WHEREAS, while swimming in her life preserver, Abigail was separated from the boat by a strong current and began to drift away, followed by Chase who tried to retrieve her and by her father trying to retrieve both his children. As Steven Poust pursued his drifting daughter, young Chase changed course and swam toward shore to seek help; and

WHEREAS, fighting the strong current and alternating between swimming and resting by floating on his back, Chase Poust kept at his task for an hour until he covered the mile to shore and ran to a nearby house to raise the alarm. During Chase's swim to shore, Steven Poust reached his daughter and the two floated in the river with the current for another hour or more until teams from the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department, Jacksonville Sheriff's Office and Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission located the pair and brought them safely to shore; and

WHEREAS, Chase Poust's quick action, calm thinking,
