This contract will assist the provider to serve as a partner with Duval County Public Schools 5,000 Role Models of Excellence Project. The partnership will follow the guidelines as outlined below.

Program Design Requirements:

While serving on the Miami-Dade County School Board, **Congresswoman Frederica S. Wilson** noticed a pattern of young minority young men being incarcerated, entering the drug trade, or dropping out of school.

Congresswoman Wilson began to challenge the men of Miami-Dade County to intervene in the lives of minority male youth. Thus, in March 1993, initiated by the Miami-Dade County School Board, the 500 African American Male Role Models of Excellence was born. Wilson's vision gained an immediate response from the community and continues to serve as a major force in the transition of raising young boys into manhood. In 1994 the name was converted to the 500 Role Models of Excellence Project. Due to the increased enrollment of mentors and students, it is now recognized as the 5,000 Role Models of Excellence Project.

During the 2015-2016 school year, the 5,000 Role Models of Excellence Project was initiated in Duval County Public Schools. Currently DCPS has 17 sites that includes elementary, middle, and high schools.

The 5,000 Role Models of Excellence Project will recruit 500 community mentors over a 10-year period (5,000 mentors nationally) to serve as role models for young African-American males.

Number of Students

The project will provide service to 558 students from the schools in Duval County listed below.
