AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING A CONTINUATION GRANT; APPROPRIATING \$6,506,417.00 IN ANNUAL STATE HOUSING INITIATIVES PARTNERSHIP (SHIP) PROGRAM GRANT FUNDING FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY, THROUGH THE FLORIDA HOUSING FINANCE CORPORATION, TO SERVE VERY LOW, LOW, AND MODERATE-INCOME FAMILIES, AS INITIATED BY REVISED B.T. 21-074; PURPOSE OF APPROPRIATION; APPROVING POSITIONS, AS INITIATED BY R.C. 21-122; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

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The funding above is an appropriation of \$6,506,417.00 in annual grant funds from Florida Department of Economic Opportunity, through the Florida Housing Finance Corporation, for the State Housing Initiatives Partnership (SHIP) program. The SHIP program grant funds must be committed to eligible projects no later than June 30, 2022 and must be fully expended for completed projects no later than June 30, 2023.

10 Section 2. Purpose. The Florida Housing Finance Corporation provides funding to local governments as an incentive 11 to create partnerships that produce and preserve affordable 12 homeownership and multifamily housing. The SHIP program was 13 designed to serve very low, low, and moderate-income families. SHIP 14 15 may be used for emergency repairs, new construction, funds rehabilitation, down payment and closing costs assistance, impact 16 17 fees, construction and gap financing, mortgage buy-downs, acquisition of property for affordable housing, matching dollars 18 19 for federal housing grants and programs, and homeownership 20 counseling. The Schedule of Proposed Funding detailing the proposed 21 uses of the SHIP funds is attached hereto as Revised Exhibit 2, 22 labeled as "Revised Exhibit 2, Rev Funding Details, June 14, 2021 -NCSPHS" and incorporated herein by this reference. A copy of the 23 state of Florida Projected SHIP Estimates for Fiscal Year 2021-2022 24 25 is attached hereto as **Revised Exhibit 3**, labeled as "Revised 26 Exhibit 3, Rev Proj Estimates, June 14, 2021 - NCSPHS".

27 Section 3. Approval of Positions. There is hereby 28 approved the positions more fully described in R.C. 21-122, 29 attached hereto as **Exhibit 4** and incorporated herein by this 30 reference. Said positions are fully funded by SHIP grant dollars 31 and will provide services in support of the SHIP program.
