ORDINANCE 2021-316-W

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE COUNCIL RULES;

AMENDING COUNCIL RULE 1.101 (OFFICERS),

CHAPTER 1 (ORGANIZATION OF THE COUNCIL),

COUNCIL RULES, TO ALLOW ONLY AT-LARGE COUNCIL

MEMBERS TO BE ELIGIBLE TO BE PRESIDENT OF THE

COUNCIL AND THE VICE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL

AND TO SERVE ON A ROTATION BASIS; PROVIDING AN

EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, At-Large Council members are elected by all of the citizens of Jacksonville and therefore ostensibly serve the interests of all the citizens of Jacksonville; and

WHEREAS, District Council members are elected by the constituents within their respective districts with the primary role of serving the needs and interests of those constituents; and

WHEREAS, the present Council Rules which call for an "open" election of its officers consistently results in creating disharmony among the body as whole; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Amending Council Rule 1.101 (Officers), Chapter 1 (Organization of the Council), Council Rules.

Rule 1.101 (Officers), Chapter 1 (Organization of the Council), Council Rules, is hereby amended to read as follows:

CHAPTER 1. OFFICERS

PART 1. OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES

RULE 1.101 OFFICERS

(a) Elected Officers. The elected officers of the Council

shall be a President of the Council and a Vice President of the Council. These officers shall be elected recognized as designate officers at the second regular meeting of the Council in May of each year as set forth in Rule 1.102 and shall assume office as of July 1 of each year, to serve until their successors are chosen recognized and qualified or until the expiration of their terms as Council Members, whichever first occurs. They shall take or sign an oath, prior to assuming office, to support the Constitution of the United States and of the State of Florida and the Charter of the City, and to truly and faithfully discharge the duties of their respective offices to the best of their knowledge and ability.

- (b) Effective May 2027, only At-Large Council Members are eligible to be President of the Council and the Vice President of the of the Council. Beginning July 1, 2027, the Group 1 At-Large Council Member will assume the role of Council President and the Group 2 At-Large Council Member will assume the role of the Council Vice President.
- (c) The Council Vice President, beginning the following July

 1, shall accede to the Council President office, leaving the

 Council Vice President office vacant.
- (d) The vacant Council Vice President office shall be filled by the next numerically successive At-Large Group Council Member.
- (e) Exception: In order that the Body is assured of experienced leadership, the only other condition for Council President qualification is that the At Large member have least one year's experience as a Member of the City Council. Should the Council President not qualify, the next qualified At Large Council Member shall serve as the Council President. The rotation will be adjusted accordingly.
- $\frac{\text{(b)}_{-}(\text{f})}{\text{(f)}}$ Appointed Officers. The appointed officers of the Council shall be those as established by Chapter 10 of the

Ordinance Code. 1 Section 2. Effective Date.
