ORDINANCE APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER THAT CERTAIN LEASE AGREEMENT (THE "LEASE") BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND NATIONAL MEDICAL SERVICES, INC., D/B/A NMS LABS, FOR LEASE OF THE SECOND FLOOR OF THE DISTRICT IV MEDICAL EXAMINER'S 2100 JEFFERSON OFFICE BUILDING LOCATED ATSTREET, JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA 32209, FOR AN INITIAL TERM OF FIVE (5) YEARS BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2020, WITH OPTIONS TO RENEW FOR UP TO FIVE (5) ADDITIONAL ONE (1) YEAR TERMS, AT AN INITIAL ANNUAL RENTAL RATE OF \$98,880.00, WITH 3% ANNUAL INCREASES THEREAFTER; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT OF LEASE APPROVAL AND EXECUTION THE REAL ESTATE DIVISION, PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, AND THEREAFTER BY THE DISTRICT IV MEDICAL EXAMINER'S OFFICE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Agreement Approved and Execution Lease There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his Authorized. designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver that certain Lease Agreement between the City of Jacksonville ("Landlord") and National Medical Services, Inc.,

d/b/a NMS Labs, ("Tenant"), in substantially the form placed On File with the Office of Legislative Services. The Lease provides for the lease from Landlord to Tenant of approximately 4,309 square feet of space on the second floor of the District IV Medical Examiner's Office ("MEO") building located at 2100 Jefferson Street, Jacksonville, Florida 32209. The tenant currently uses and occupies the leased premises for the provision of toxicology services to the MEO to meet accreditation requirements. initial term of the Lease will be five (5) years beginning on October 1, 2020, with options to renew for up to five (5) additional one (1) year terms. The initial annual rental rate is \$98,880.00, with three percent (3%) increases annually thereafter. The value of the toxicology services provided by the Tenant to the MEO will be used to offset the Tenant's annual rent in accordance with the Services Agreement between the MEO and the Tenant dated October 1, 2020.

Section 2. Oversight Department. The Real Estate Division of the Department of Public Works shall provide initial oversight of the Lease through the legislative approval process and execution. The District IV Medical Examiner's Office shall thereafter provide administrative oversight of the Lease.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
