AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$225,000 FROM THE 9 10 SOCIAL JUSTICE AND COMMUNITY INVESTMENT 11 SPECIAL COMMITTEE CONTINGENCY FOR THE QUENCH THE VIOLENCE REWORK PROGRAM; APPROVING, AND 12 13 AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND 14 CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, 15 AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE 16 AND QUENCH THE VIOLENCE, INC.; INVOKING THE 17 EXCEPTION IN SECTION 126.107(G), ORDINANCE 18 CODE, TO ALLOW DIRECT CONTRACT WITH QUENCH THE 19 VIOLENCE, INC. TO PROVIDE THE SERVICES FOR THE 20 QUENCH THE VIOLENCE REWORK PROGRAM; WAIVING 21 SECTION 110.112 (ADVANCE OF CITY FUNDS; 22 PROHIBITION AGAINST), PART 1 (THE CITY 23 TREASURY), CHAPTER 110 (CITY TREASURY), 24 ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW FOR A PARTIAL ADVANCE 25 PAYMENT BY THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR A REVERTER 26 PROVISION FOR LAWN EQUIPMENT; PROVIDING FOR 27 OVERSIGHT BY THE OFFICE OF GRANTS AND CONTRACT 28 COMPLIANCE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

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Appropriation. For the 2020-2021 fiscal year, 1 Section 1. 2 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the 3 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b): 4 (The account information is attached hereto as Exhibit 1, and 5 6 incorporated herein by this reference) 7 (a) Appropriated from: See attached Exhibit 1 \$225,000 8 9 (b) Appropriated to: 10 See attached **Exhibit 1** \$225,000 Explanation of Appropriation - The funding above is being 11 (C) appropriated from the Social Justice and Community 12 Investment Special Committee Contingency to be utilized 13 by Quench the Violence, Inc. for the Quench the Violence 14

ReWork program.

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Section 2. **Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in 16 Section 1 is to provide funding for the Quench the Violence ReWork 17 18 program as more fully described in **Revised Exhibit 2**, labeled as 19 "Revised Exhibit 2, Rev Scope, June 14, 2021 - NCSPHS" attached 20 hereto. The Quench the Violence ReWork program will equip 21 unemployed, underemployed and justice involved young adults in 22 Jacksonville who have aged out of public education (18 to 30) with 23 the personal, psycho-social and self-awareness skills, training and 24 credentials to excel in obtaining a sustainable career pathway as 25 productive citizens in our community. It will provide wrap-around 26 services for justice involved and unemployed/underemployed 27 residents of Jacksonville, ages 18 to 30.

28 Section 3. Agreement approved and execution authorized. 29 There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and 30 Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, 31 the Funding Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and Quench

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1 the Violence, Inc., in substantially the form as attached hereto as 2 Revised Exhibit 3, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 3, Rev Agmt, June 3 14, 2021 - NCSPHS", and incorporated herein by this reference (the "Agreement"). The Agreement may include such additions, deletions 4 5 and changes as may be reasonable, necessary and incidental for carrying out the purposes thereof, as may be acceptable to the 6 7 Mayor, or his designee, with such inclusion and acceptance being 8 evidenced by execution of the Agreement by the Mayor, or his 9 designee; provided however, no modification to the Agreement may 10 increase the financial obligations or liability of the City to an amount in excess of the amount stated in the Agreement or decrease 11 12 the duties and obligations of Quench the Violence, Inc., and any such modification shall be technical only and shall be subject to 13 appropriate legal review and approval by the Office of General 14 15 Counsel. For the purposes of this Ordinance, the term "technical changes" is defined as those changes having no financial impact to 16 17 the City and any other non-substantive changes that do not substantively increase the duties and responsibilities of the City 18 19 under the provisions of the Agreement.

Invoking the exception to Section 126.107(g), 20 Section 4. 21 Ordinance Code. The City is hereby authorized to procure the use of 22 the professional services of Quench the Violence, Inc., to provide 23 services for the Quench the Violence ReWork program. Pursuant to 24 Section 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code, such procurement is 25 exempted from competitive solicitation because the supplies or 26 services are to be provided by those specifically prescribed within 27 28 authorizing legislation that appropriates the same. With the exception of the foregoing, all other provisions of Chapter 126, 29 Ordinance Code, shall remain in full force and effect. 30

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Section 5. Waiving Section 110.112, Ordinance Code.

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Section 110.112 (Advance of City funds; prohibition against), Part
1 (The City Treasury), Chapter 110 (City Treasury), Ordinance Code,
is hereby waived to allow for a partial advance payment as
described in the Agreement.

Reverter. The Funding Agreement authorized in 5 Section 6. Section 3 is conditioned upon Quench the Violence, Inc. using the 6 7 said lawn equipment authorized for purchase for the purposes set forth herein and is conditioned upon Quench the Violence, Inc. 8 9 agreeing to convey the lawn equipment to the City of Jacksonville 10 in the event that the lawn equipment is not used for those purposes or in the event that Quench the Violence, Inc. elects to sell the 11 lawn equipment within a five-year period from the effective date. 12

13 Section 7. Oversight. The Mayor is requested to appoint 14 the Office of Grants and Contract Compliance to oversee the project 15 in Section 2 above and to ensure compliance with all other 16 appropriate laws.

Section 8. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
