(C) Explanation of Appropriation - The funding above is being appropriated from the Social Justice and Community Investment Special Committee Contingency to provide the Mental Health Offender additional funding for Program, a jail diversion program for mentally ill misdemeanor offenders, and additional wrap around services, including Housing, transportation, communication needs of the MHOP participants managed by the Sulzbacher Center.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide additional funding for the Mental Health Offender Program (MHOP), which is a jail diversion program for mentally ill misdemeanor offenders, as more fully described in Revised Exhibit 2, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 2, Rev Scope, June 14, 2021 - NCSPHS" attached hereto. The MHOP operational services is managed by the Sulzbacher Center.

Agreement approved and execution authorized. Section 3. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, the First Amendment to the Funding Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and the I.M. Sulzbacher Center for the Homeless, Inc., in substantially the form as attached hereto as Revised Exhibit 3,

labeled as "Revised Exhibit 3, Rev Agmt, June 14, 2021 - NCSPHS", and incorporated herein by this reference (the "Agreement"). The Agreement may include such additions, deletions and changes as may be reasonable, necessary and incidental for carrying out purposes thereof, as may be acceptable to the Mayor, or his designee, with such inclusion and acceptance being evidenced by execution of the Agreement by the Mayor, or his designee; provided modification to the Agreement may however, no increase financial obligations or liability of the City to an amount in excess of the amount stated in the Agreement or decrease the duties and obligations of the Sulzbacher Center as stated Agreement, and any such modification shall be technical only and shall be subject to appropriate legal review and approval by the Office of General Counsel. For the purposes of this Ordinance, the term "technical changes" is defined as those changes having no financial impact to the City and any other non-substantive changes that do not substantively increase the duties and responsibilities of the City under the provisions of the Agreement.

Section 4. Invoking the exception to Section 126.107(g), Ordinance Code. The City is hereby authorized to procure the use of the professional services of the Sulzbacher Center, to provide additional services to the MHOP program, a jail diversion program for mentally ill misdemeanor offenders. Pursuant to Section 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code, such procurement is exempted from competitive solicitation because the supplies or services are to be provided by those specifically prescribed within authorizing legislation that appropriates the same. With the exception of the foregoing, all other provisions of Chapter 126, Ordinance Code, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. Reverter. The First Amendment to the Funding

Agreement authorized in Section 3 is conditioned upon I.M.
Sulzbacher Center for the Homeless, Inc. using the said vehicle
authorized for purchase for the purposes set forth herein and is
conditioned upon I.M. Sulzbacher Center for the Homeless, Inc.
agreeing to convey the vehicle to the City of Jacksonville in the
event that the vehicle is not used for those purposes or in the
event that I.M. Sulzbacher Center for the Homeless, Inc. elects to
