City in connection with admission fees for special events, rentals, dock slip rentals, equipment and service charges, and other funds from activities and events conducted or authorized by the City in the Park.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funds for maintenance and operation of the Park and to support the operational and production costs associated with City co-sponsored special events in the Park. The funds will be used for a wide range of expenses, including payment of annual utilities and to procure supplies and services as necessary for repairs to docks and fencing, sidewalk and concrete repairs throughout the park, replacement of picnic benches, and annual landscape mulch replacement. A portion of the funds will be used to procure heavy equipment that will assist in maintenance and operations activities for special events in the Park at the current level of service without the need for additional personnel.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
