30 WHEREAS, Mr. Gabriel provided dedicated legal counsel to the City and its independent agencies in a variety of substantive areas 31

of law including but not limited to serving as lead counsel to: (i) 1 2 the City on Land Use and Zoning matters (advising the Planning Commission and Land Use and Zoning Committee of the City Council), 3 (ii) the City on Community Redevelopment Agency matters (including 4 5 the creation, operation and lead representation of the Downtown Investment Authority), (iii) the City on Ethics matters (including 6 7 counsel to the Ethics Commission and Ethics Office on inquiries and complaints, as well as representation of officials before the State 8 9 of Florida's Commission on Ethics); (iv) the Supervisor of 10 Elections regarding elections law matters (including instances of recounts); (v) JEA, JAXPORT, the Pension Funds, Duval County School 11 Board and other agencies in various agency matters; (vi) the City 12 in Redistricting and other special projects, and (vii) the City and 13 independent agencies in litigation matters, 14 its economic 15 development, public policy and legal strategy; and

16 WHEREAS, Mr. Gabriel is renowned for his tenacious advocacy of 17 the Consolidated City of Jacksonville's assertion of its Charter 18 authority, his dedicated hard work on behalf of his clients, and 19 the effective and excellent representation of his clients; and

WHEREAS, in 2014 Mr. Gabriel was appointed General Counsel by Mayor Alvin Brown, and he was subsequently reappointed and unanimously confirmed to full terms as General Counsel by Mayor Lenny Curry in 2015 and 2019; and

WHEREAS Mr. Gabriel is Board Certified by the Florida Bar in City, County and Local Government Law; Florida Trend Magazine has recognized him as one of Florida's top government attorneys by designating him as a "Legal EliteTM" attorney; and he has been awarded a rating of "AV Preeminent®" by Martindale-Hubbell, indicating that his peer lawyers rank his legal ability and ethical standards among the highest in the legal community; and
