A RESOLUTION HONORING THE LIFE AND MOURNING THE PASSING OF ARNOLD TRITT; REQUESTING EMERGENCY PASSAGE UPON INTRODUCTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Arnold Tritt was born on February 7, 1934 in Jacksonville, Florida, where he and his two older siblings, Millicent and Abner, were raised by their mother, Rose, in the Brentwood public housing project on the Northside. Arnold Tritt, along with his lifelong best friend (former Jacksonville Mayor and Council Member) Jake Godbold, graduated from Andrew Jackson High School; and

21 WHEREAS, after high school, Mr. Tritt enlisted in the U.S. Army 22 and was stationed in occupied Germany during the post W.W. II 23 years. After his return from active duty, he graduated from the 24 University of Florida with degrees in both Journalism and Public 25 Relations; and

26 WHEREAS, Arnold Tritt met Virginia ("Ginger") Lee Ford in 27 Birmingham, Alabama shortly after graduation and was immediately 28 smitten with her. The following day they went out for dinner and 29 they were inseparable thereafter. Arnold and Ginger moved back to 30 Jacksonville for the wedding, where they shared almost sixty years

1 of marriage, raised their sons, Arnold, Jr., Lee-Ford and John, and 2 then later were blessed with four grandchildren: Lillie Rose, Lee-3 Ford, Noah and Nathaniel; and

WHEREAS, in the early 1970's, the Tritts moved to the Avondale 4 5 neighborhood and Arnold worked as a truancy officer because he loved helping young people. A few years later, Arnold was hired to 6 7 be the Executive Officer for the Northeast Florida Builders Association (NEFBA). Under his leadership the organization grew 8 9 from a grassroots operation with 180 members, to one with over 3000 10 members, one of the largest homebuilders' associations in the country. While in that position, an important passion project for 11 Arnold was the NEFBA apprenticeship program, which provided youth 12 13 with the opportunity for successful careers in the construction industry; and 14

WHEREAS, after retirement, Arnold Tritt was awarded the 15 Lifetime Achievement Award from the National Association of Home 16 17 Builders and was inducted into the Florida Home Builders Hall of Fame. He also served in many civil capacities over the years, 18 including as the President of the Jacksonville Jaycees, the City of 19 20 Jacksonville's Sister City Association, the Chairman of Muscular 21 Dystrophy, Chair of the Boys & Girls Club, Chairman of the 22 Jacksonville Transportation Authority, Chairman of Big Brothers, 23 and Board Member for the Jacksonville Police and Fire Pension Fund; 24 and

25 WHEREAS, Arnold Tritt passed away on July 1, 2021 at home 26 surrounded by family. He will be remembered for his love of fishing 27 with Jake, helping others, and sharing time with friends and family 28 wherein he always insisted on picking-up the restaurant bill. 29 Arnold's life was full of love, friendship and kindness and he will 30 be dearly missed by all who to knew him; now therefore
