6 A RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE PROPOSED AD  
7 VALOREM TAX MILLAGE RATES FOR THE 2021 TAX  
8 YEAR; ADVISING THE PROPERTY APPRAISER OF THE  
9 "ROLLED-BACK RATE" AND PROPOSED MILLAGE RATES  
10 FOR THE GENERAL SERVICES DISTRICT, EXCEPTING  
11 URBAN SERVICES DISTRICTS 2 THROUGH 5 (THE  
12 BEACHES AND THE TOWN OF BALDWIN), FOR THE  
13 GENERAL SERVICES DISTRICT, INCLUDING ONLY  
14 URBAN SERVICES DISTRICTS 2, 3, AND 4 (THE  
15 BEACHES); AND FOR THE GENERAL SERVICES  
16 DISTRICT, INCLUDING ONLY URBAN SERVICES  
17 DISTRICT 5 (THE TOWN OF BALDWIN); SETTING THE  
18 DATE, TIME AND PLACE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING TO  
19 CONSIDER THE PROPOSED 2021 MILLAGE RATES AND  
20 THE TENTATIVE CONSOLIDATED GOVERNMENT BUDGET  
21 FOR THE 2021-2022 FISCAL YEAR; REQUESTING  
22 EMERGENCY PASSAGE; DIRECTING THE CHIEF OF  
23 LEGISLATIVE SERVICES TO DELIVER A COPY OF THIS  
24 RESOLUTION TO THE PROPERTY APPRAISER UPON  
25 ADOPTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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27 **WHEREAS**, the Property Appraiser has certified to the Council  
28 the taxable value of real property within the City's taxing  
29 jurisdiction, which certification was provided by July 1, 2021; and

30 **WHEREAS**, Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, requires that the

1 Council advise the Property Appraiser of the "rolled-back rate," of  
2 the proposed millage rate and of the date of a public hearing on  
3 the proposed rates and the tentative budget within thirty-five days  
4 of the certification by the Property Appraiser; now, therefore

5 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

6 **Section 1. 2021 Rolled-back Rate Established.** Based upon  
7 the certified taxable values provided by the Property Appraiser,  
8 the Council has computed and hereby establishes that the "rolled-  
9 back rate" of millage under s. 200.065(1), Florida Statutes, is  
10 10.9462 mills, or \$10.9462 per \$1,000 assessed taxable value, for  
11 the General Services District, excepting Urban Services Districts 2  
12 through 5 (the Beaches and the Town of Baldwin); is 7.7765 mills,  
13 or \$7.7765 per \$1,000 assessed taxable value, for the General  
14 Services District, including only Urban Services Districts 2, 3,  
15 and 4 (the Beaches); and is 8.9832 mills, or \$8.9832 per \$1,000  
16 assessed taxable value, for the General Services District,  
17 including only Urban Services District 5 (the Town of Baldwin).

18 **Section 2. Proposed 2021 Millage Rates.** Based upon the  
19 certified taxable values stated in Section 1, and upon  
20 consideration of public spirited and competing community interests,  
21 the Council proposes to levy millage rates for the 2021 tax year as  
22 follows:

23 **2021 PROPOSED MILLAGE RATES**

24 **General Services District, excepting Urban Services Districts 2**  
25 **through 5 (the Beaches and the Town of Baldwin)**

26 11.4419 mills (operations), or \$11.4419 per \$1,000 of assessed  
27 taxable value;

28 **General Services District, including only Urban Services Districts**  
29 **2, 3, and 4 (the Beaches)**

30 8.1512 mills (operations), or \$8.1512 per \$1,000 of assessed  
31 taxable value;

**General Services District, including only Urban Services District 5  
(the Town of Baldwin):**

9.6312 mills (operations), or \$9.6312 per \$1,000 of assessed taxable value;

**Section 3. Date, Time and Place for Public Hearing.** The Council will hold a public hearing to consider the proposed 2021 millage rates and the tentative Consolidated Government budget on September 14, 2021, at 5:01 p.m. in the Council Chambers, 1st Floor, City Hall, at 117 West Duval Street, Jacksonville, Florida.

**Section 4. Requesting Emergency Passage, Pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency.** Emergency passage of this resolution is requested. The nature of the emergency is the requirement, pursuant to Section 200.065(2)(b), that the Council advise the Property Appraiser of the "rolled-back rate," of the proposed millage rates and of the date of a public hearing on the proposed rates and tentative budget within thirty-five days of the certification by the Property Appraiser.

**Section 5. Delivery to the Property Appraiser.** The Chief of Legislative Services shall, upon approval of this resolution, forthwith deliver a fully executed copy of this resolution to the Duval County Property Appraiser.

**Section 6. Effective Date.** This resolution shall become effective upon signature by the Council President.
