The Development Order for Bartram Park DRI is Section 1. 8 9 hereby amended to incorporate the proposed changes and 10 modifications contained in the AFC dated April 29, 2021, and attached hereto as Exhibit 1, which changes are generally described 11 10.89± acres to the DRI for multi-family 12 adding adding as 13 residential uses.

Section 2. The Council hereby finds and determines that the changes and modifications set forth in the AFC dated April 19, 2021, are consistent with the 2030 Comprehensive Plan and the City's Land Development Regulations.
