(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above comprises \$400,000.00 in grant funds from the Florida Department of Children and Families and an additional appropriation of \$85,000.00 from the Kids Hope Alliance ("KHA"), for implementation of the Criminal Justice, Mental Health and Substance Abuse Reinvestment Grant Program.

30 Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in 31 Section 1 is to fund the first year of local implementation and

expansion of the Criminal Justice, Mental Health and Substance 1 Abuse Reinvestment Grant Program (the "Program") for the period 2 beginning July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022. The overall grant 3 term is three (3) years beginning July 1, 2021 and ending June 30, 4 5 2024. A copy of the Florida Department of Children and Families Criminal Justice, Mental Health and Substance Abuse Reinvestment 6 7 Grant Award Notice # DCF RFA 2021-001 is attached hereto as Exhibit 8 2 and incorporated herein by this reference. A copy of the budget 9 schedule reflecting the intended sources and uses of funds for the 10 first year of the grant is attached hereto as Exhibit 3.

Amending Fifth Revised Schedule M to Ordinance 11 Section 3. 2020-511-E. There is hereby amended for the fiscal year 2020-2021 12 budget for the Kids Hope Alliance by substituting in the place of 13 Fifth Revised Schedule M, approved by Ordinance 2020-511-E, 14 the 15 Sixth Revised Schedule M, attached hereto as **Exhibit 4** and incorporated herein by this reference. The Sixth Revised Schedule M 16 17 will reflect additional transfers and funds appropriated herein.

18 Section 4. Invoking the exception to Section 126.107(g), 19 Ordinance Code. KHA is hereby authorized to procure 20 professional services from Managed Access to Child Health, Inc. 21 ("MATCH") for local implementation and expansion of the Program in 22 compliance with the grant authorized in Section 1 above. Pursuant to Section 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations), 23 24 Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code, such services are 25 exempted from competitive solicitation because the services to be 26 provided are being approved via authorizing legislation pursuant to 27 this Ordinance.

28 Section 5. Approval and Authorization to Execute. The 29 Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary, and/or the 30 Chief Executive Officer of KHA, are hereby authorized to execute 31 and deliver a contract between KHA and Managed Access to Child

Health, Inc. pursuant to which MATCH will provide professional
 services necessary for local implementation and expansion of the
 Program in compliance with the grant authorized in Section 1.

Section 6. Waiver of the requirements of Chapter 77 (Kids 4 Hope Alliance), Section 77.111(a) (Provider Contracts), Ordinance 5 Code. The City hereby waives the requirements of Chapter 77 (Kids 6 7 Hope Alliance), Section 77.111(a) (Provider Contracts), Ordinance Code, with respect to the contract with Managed Access to Child 8 9 Health, Inc. approved and authorized in Section 5 of this 10 Section 77.111(a) requires contracts for children's Ordinance. services provided by third parties to be competitively procured by 11 KHA via an evaluated bid process. This waiver is needed in order 12 to allow KHA to directly contract with Managed Access to Child 13 Health, Inc. to provide the Program services included in the 14 15 approved grant application.

Section 7. Oversight Department. The Kids Hope Alliance
shall oversee administration of the grant and the Program.

18 Section 8. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become 19 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 20 without the Mayor's signature.
