A RESOLUTION HONORING AND COMMENDING CITY

COUNCIL EXECUTIVE ADMINSTRATOR LAURA DYER FOR

HER LONG CAREER OF PUBLIC SERVICE ON THE

OCCASION OF HER RETIREMENT; PROVIDING AN

EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Laura Dyer, a native of Jacksonville and graduate of Duval County Public Schools, descends from generations of distinguished public servants in Florida, including a Florida Superintendent of Schools in the early 20th century, numerous judges and state legislators, a father who worked for the City for 34 years, a mother who was a Duval Public Schools teacher and a husband who retired after a 41-year career with JEA; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Dyer began her own public service career as a clerk in the City's Water Services Division in 1988 and transferred to the Solid Waste Division as a personnel clerk before joining the City Council staff in 1994 as a civil service Council Aide serving as the secretarial assistant to two council members. She transitioned to an Executive Council Assistant when that position was created in 1996, also serving two council members; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Dyer took a position in the City's Human Resources Department as a Personnel Assistant for several years, then returned to the City Council in 2001 as an Executive Administrator handling the Council's personnel and accounting functions including recruitment and hiring, new employee orientation, insurance, payroll, time and attendance, leave processing, and accounts payable functions. In the last two decades her scope of responsibilities has

expanded to incorporate more areas of responsibility including maintenance and updating of the Council's standard operating procedures manual, processing of travel requests, managing the Value Adjustment Board database, managing and inventorying computer and communication equipment assigned to council members and staff, and serving as the Council's departmental Ethics Officer. For many years she has played a pivotal role in the preparation and submission of the City Council's budget; and

WHEREAS, throughout her career with the City, particularly her time with the City Council, Laura Dyer has been an outstanding and invaluable employee who never disappoints, consistently going above and beyond the call of duty to ensure that tasks are completed accurately and timely to keep the work of the Council moving smoothly. She is a scrupulous record keeper, maintaining voluminous historical documentation of past policies, practices and ordinances that provides valuable historical context about past policies and problems when new changes are being considered; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Dyer's dedication to the City Council and its council members and employees is legendary, and she has been a true friend and sage advisor to generations of city council members for over two decades and an invaluable partner to the Council staff and to her supervisors; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

The City Council hereby honors and commends Laura Dyer for her decades of outstanding service to the City government and the City Council on the occasion of her retirement and extends its best wishes for many years of health and happiness in her retirement. Ms. Dyer has been an invaluable asset and a true friend to the Council, and her many contributions are gratefully acknowledged and will be long remembered.
