The funding above is an appropriation of \$2,532,308.00 from the City's General Fund - General Service District fund balance recaptured from fiscal year 2020-2021 close out to provide KHA Out-of-School Time learning recovery programming for students impacted by COVID-19 and to correct a 2017 accounting error that resulted in a deficit in the KHA SAMHSA High-Fidelity Wraparound Services and Integrated Care Coordination for Children and Youth Program grant fund.

14 Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in 15 Section 1 is to transfer \$724,786.00 in recaptured City General Fund - General Service District fund balance to correct an accounting 16 error that resulted in a deficit in the KHA SAMHSA High-Fidelity 17 Wraparound Services and Integrated Care Coordination for Children and 18 19 Youth Program grant fund. This transfer will bring this account to 20 a zero balance, allowing the grant to be closed. The remaining 21 \$1,807,522.00 in recaptured funds will be used to provide expanded 22 KHA Out-of-School Time learning opportunities through afterschool, summer and learning recovery programs for students impacted by COVID-23 24 19.

25 Section 3. Carryover. The funds appropriated in this 26 Ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year 2021-27 2022.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
