AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING A \$610,000.00 GRANT FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION ("FDOT") TO FUND CONSTRUCTION AND CONSTRUCTION OVERSIGHT FOR INSTALLATION OF AN INTELLIGENT TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM ON BAY STREET FROM I-95 TO FESTIVAL PARK DRIVE (THE "PROJECT"), INITIATED BY B.T. 21-110; PURPOSE OF THE APPROPRIATION; APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, THE LOCAL AGENCY PROGRAM AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND FDOT; AMENDING THE 2021-2025 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2020-505-E TO REFLECT FDOT GRANT FUNDING FOR THE PROJECT; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE ENGINEERING AND CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2020-2021 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above represents a grant from the Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") for the City's construction and construction oversight of the Project.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to fund the costs of construction and construction oversight for installation of an Intelligent Transportation System on Bay Street from I-95 to Festival Park Drive. The purpose of the Project is to provide greater stormwater resiliency, traffic cameras for transportation operations and public safety, and fiber-optic communications for future expansion opportunities.

Section 3. Approval and Authorization. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City, the Local Agency Program Agreement between the City and FDOT, in substantially the same form as has been placed On File with the Office of Legislative Services.

Section 4. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment. Ordinance 2020-505-E, adopting the 2021-2025 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to provide funding for the Project, as more fully described in the Project Information Sheet, attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference. The City Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such deferral will result in unnecessary delay of the Project and loss of grant funding for the Project. Pursuant

 to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2020-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2020-505-E shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

Section 5. Departmental Oversight. The Engineering and Construction Management Division of the Department of Public Works shall oversee the Project.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
