AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$275,000.00 FROM THE SPECIAL LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND (THE "FUND") FOR DONATIONS TO NORTH FLORIDA COUNCIL, INC., BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA (\$10,000.00), THE PARENT HELP CENTER, INC. (\$20,000.00), FIRST COAST CRIME STOPPERS, INC. (\$23,000.00), FLORIDA CRIME PREVENTION ASSOCIATION INCORPORATED (\$1,000.00), AND THE NATIONAL LAW ENFORCEMENT MEMORIAL AND MUSEUM (\$1,000.00), IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 932.7055(5), FLORIDA STATUTES, TO SUPPORT DRUG TREATMENT, DRUG ABUSE EDUCATION, DRUG PREVENTION, CRIME PREVENTION, SAFE NEIGHBORHOODS, AND SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER PROGRAM(S), TRANSFERRING \$12,500.00 FROM THE FUND TO THE TEEN DRIVER SPECIAL REVENUE FUND FOR THE TEEN DRIVER CHALLENGE PROGRAM, IN ACCORDANCE 111.365, ORDINANCE CODE, WITH SECTION TRANSFERRING \$7,500.00 FROM THE FUND TO THE POLICE EXPLORERS TRUST FUND FOR THE JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S POLICE EXPLORER POST, APPROPRIATING \$200,000.00 TO PROCURE AND INSTALL VARIOUS SECURITY FENCING ATJACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE FACILITIES; PURPOSE OF APPROPRIATION; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, MISCELLANEOUS APPROPRIATIONS

AGREEMENTS BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND NORTH FLORIDA COUNCIL, INC., BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA, THE PARENT HELP CENTER, INC., AND FIRST COAST CRIME STOPPERS, INC.; PROVIDING FOR CITY OVERSIGHT BY THE JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2020-2021 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above represents an appropriation of \$275,000.00 from the Special Law Enforcement Trust Fund for donations to various organizations as set forth herein to support drug treatment, drug abuse education, drug prevention, crime prevention, safe neighborhood, and/or school resource officers programs administered by various agencies in accordance with Section 932.7055(5), Florida Statutes. In addition, the funding above includes a transfer of \$12,500.00 from the Fund to the Teen Driver Special Revenue Fund for the Teen Driver Challenge Program in accordance with Section 111.365, Ordinance Code, and a transfer of \$7,500.00 from the Fund to the Police Explorers

Trust Fund for the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office Police Explorer Post, in accordance with Section 111.340, Ordinance Code. This funding also includes an appropriation of \$200,000.00 to purchase and install security fencing at various Jacksonville Sheriff's Office facilities.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide donations to the following organizations, in the stated amounts: North Florida Council, Inc., Boy Scouts of America (\$10,000.00), The Parent Help Center, Inc. (\$20,000.00), First Coast Inc. (\$23,000.00), Florida Crime Stoppers, Prevention (\$1,000.00), Association Incorporated and the National Enforcement Memorial and Museum (\$1,000.00). This allocation supports drug treatment, drug abuse education, drug prevention, crime prevention, safe neighborhood, and/or school resource officer programs for the citizens of the City of Jacksonville, Duval County, Florida. A Certification from the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office that the subject appropriation from the Special Law Enforcement Trust Fund complies with Section 932.7055, Florida Statutes, is attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference.

In addition to the above, this appropriation includes a transfer of \$12,500.00 from the Fund to the Teen Driver Special Revenue Fund for the Teen Driver Challenge Program in accordance with Section 111.365, Ordinance Code, as well as a transfer of \$7,500.00 from the Fund to the Police Explorers Trust Fund for the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office Police Explorer Post, in accordance with Section 111.340, Ordinance Code, and an appropriation of \$200,000.00 for the purchase and installation of security fencing for various Jacksonville Sheriff's Office facilities.

Section 3. Approval and Authorization. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation

Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of the City, the Miscellaneous Appropriations Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and North Florida Council, Inc., Boy Scouts of America, the Miscellaneous Appropriations Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and The Parent Help Center, Inc., and the Miscellaneous Appropriations Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and First Coast Crime Stoppers, Inc. in substantially the same forms as have been placed **On File** with the Office of Legislative Services.

Section 4. Oversight. The Jacksonville Sheriff's Office shall oversee the projects described herein.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
