Transmitted herewith for your review and approval is a request to amend Ordinance Code Section 380.405 – Host Fee; Distribution formula; Late charge for delinquent payment; and the City fees associated with Ordinance Code Section 380.303 – Rates for Disposal. The purpose of the proposed amendments is to better align the origin of the host fee charges with the uses of those funds. The proposed amendment to Ordinance Code Section 380.405 removes the Landfill Closure Fund portion of \$1.98 per ton and the Solid Waste Enterprise Fund portion of \$4.44 per ton of the host fee requirements for Class III landfills and from private solid waste management facilities that accept construction and demolition debris generated outside of the City of Jacksonville. The Mitigation Fund portion of \$0.50 per ton and the Contamination Assessment and Remediation Fund portion of \$0.24 per ton of the host fee requirement would remain in effect for these facilities. The financial impact of this amendment would be offset by an increase of \$0.43 of the host fees charged at publicly owned disposal facilities (currently Trail Ridge Landfill). In order to modify the host fee charge at Trail Ridge Landfill, the City fees related to Ordinance Code Section 380.303 would need to be amended to reflect those changes. The financial goal of these changes is to be budget neutral.
