Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in 21 22 Section 1 is to fund the first year of the ReCAST Program for the 23 period beginning September 30, 2021 through September 29, 2022 and to procure the professional services of Managed Access to Child 24 25 Health, Inc. ("MATCH"), to implement and carry out the ReCAST Program. The ReCAST Program is designed to assist high-risk youth and their 26 27 families and to promote resilience and equity in communities that 28 have faced civil unrest through utilization of evidence-based 29 violence prevention and community youth engagement programs, and 30 linkage to trauma-informed behavioral health services with the intent 31 to create sustainable change in the community. A copy of the SAMHSA

1 Resiliency in Communities After Stress and Trauma Notice of Award 2 #1H79SM084915-01 is attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated 3 herein by this reference. A copy of the budget schedule reflecting 4 the intended sources and uses of funds for the first year of the 5 grant is attached hereto as **Exhibit 3**.

Amending Sixth Revised Schedule M to Ordinance 6 Section 3. 7 2020-511-E. There is hereby amended for the fiscal year 2020-2021 8 budget for Kids Hope Alliance by substituting in the place of the 9 Sixth Revised Schedule M, approved by Ordinance 2020-511-E, the 10 Seventh Revised Schedule M, attached hereto as Exhibit 4 and incorporated herein by this reference. The Seventh Revised Schedule 11 12 M will reflect additional transfers and funds appropriated herein.

13 Section 4. Invoking the exception to Section 126.107(g), 14 Ordinance Code. KHA is hereby authorized to procure professional 15 services from Managed Access to Child Health, Inc. ("MATCH") for local implementation and administration of the ReCAST Program in 16 17 compliance with the grant described in Section 2 above. Pursuant to Section 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations), 18 19 Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code, such services are 20 exempted from competitive solicitation because the services to be 21 provided are being approved via authorizing legislation pursuant to 22 this Ordinance.

23 Approval and Authorization to Execute. Section 5. The 24 Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary, and/or the 25 Chief Executive Officer of KHA, are hereby authorized to execute and 26 deliver a contract between KHA and Managed Access to Child Health, 27 Inc. pursuant to which MATCH will provide professional services 28 necessary for local implementation and administration of the ReCAST 29 Program in compliance with the grant described in Section 2.

30 Section 6. Waiver of the requirements of Chapter 77 (Kids 31 Hope Alliance), Section 77.111(a) (Provider Contracts), Ordinance

Code. The City hereby waives the requirements of Chapter 77 (Kids 1 2 Hope Alliance), Section 77.111(a) (Provider Contracts), Ordinance Code, with respect to the contract with Managed Access to Child 3 Health, Inc. approved and authorized in Section 5 of this Ordinance. 4 5 Section 77.111(a) requires contracts for children's services provided by third parties to be competitively procured by KHA via an evaluated 6 7 bid process. This waiver is needed in order to allow KHA to directly contract with MATCH to provide the ReCAST Program services described 8 9 in the approved grant application.

Section 7. Oversight Department. The Kids Hope Alliance
shall oversee administration of the grant and the ReCAST Program.

Section 8. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
