BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Amending Section 78.103 (Membership; terms), Chapter 78 (Safety and Crime Reduction Commission), Ordinance Code. Section 78.103 (Membership; terms), Chapter 78 (Safety and Crime Reduction Commission), Ordinance Code, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Chapter 78. Safety and Crime Reduction Commission

* * *

Sec. 78.103. - Membership; terms.

(a) The Commission shall be composed of no more than 20 members who shall be appointed by the City Council in accordance with the following requirements. Members shall be residents of the City of Jacksonville Duval County or have substantial business interests within the City (either employed by a business located in the City or volunteer, affiliate or serve on the board for an organization whose principal place of business is Jacksonville). Members shall serve staggered two-year terms, commencing July 1, but shall serve until their successors are appointed and confirmed. Of the initial

appointments, ten members shall serve for one-year terms, and ten members shall serve for two-year terms; but appointments to fill vacancies for partial terms (less than 50 percent of a full term) and initial appointments under the preceding sentence for less than two years shall not be deemed to be full terms. No member shall serve more than two full consecutive terms. Members appointed pursuant to this paragraph (a) shall serve at the pleasure of the Council and may be removed at any time by the Council.

Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
