4 **ORDINANCE 2021-586**

5 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 78.103  
6 (MEMBERSHIP; TERMS), CHAPTER 78 (SAFETY AND  
7 CRIME REDUCTION COMMISSION), *ORDINANCE CODE*, TO  
8 CHANGE RESIDENCY REQUIRMENTS FROM CITY OF  
9 JACKSONVILLE RESIDENT TO DUVAL COUNTY RESIDENT;  
10 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

12 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

13 **Section 1. Amending Section 78.103 (Membership; terms),**  
14 **Chapter 78 (Safety and Crime Reduction Commission), Ordinance Code.**

15 Section 78.103 (Membership; terms), Chapter 78 (Safety and Crime  
16 Reduction Commission), *Ordinance Code*, is hereby amended to read as  
17 follows:

18 **Chapter 78. Safety and Crime Reduction Commission**

19 \* \* \*

20 **Sec. 78.103. - Membership; terms.**

21 (a) The Commission shall be composed of no more than 20  
22 members who shall be appointed by the City Council in  
23 accordance with the following requirements. Members  
24 shall be residents of ~~the City of Jacksonville~~ Duval  
25 County or have substantial business interests within  
26 the City (either employed by a business located in the  
27 City or volunteer, affiliate or serve on the board for  
28 an organization whose principal place of business is  
29 Jacksonville). Members shall serve staggered two-year  
30 terms, commencing July 1, but shall serve until their  
31 successors are appointed and confirmed. Of the initial

1           appointments, ten members shall serve for one-year  
2           terms, and ten members shall serve for two-year terms;  
3           but appointments to fill vacancies for partial terms  
4           (less than 50 percent of a full term) and initial  
5           appointments under the preceding sentence for less than  
6           two years shall not be deemed to be full terms. No  
7           member shall serve more than two full consecutive terms.  
8           Members appointed pursuant to this paragraph (a) shall  
9           serve at the pleasure of the Council and may be removed  
10          at any time by the Council.

11           **Section 2. Effective Date.**     This ordinance shall become  
12          effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
13          without the Mayor's signature.
