ORDINANCE 2021-623

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE PROPOSED OCTOBER 1, 2021 - SEPTEMBER 30, 2024 COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND THE COMMUNICATIONS WORKERS OF AMERICA (CWA), REPRESENTING APPROXIMATELY 420 MEMBERS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Proposed Collective Bargaining Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and CWA approved. That certain proposed October 1, 2021 - September 30, 2024 Collective Bargaining Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and the Communications Workers of America (CWA), a copy of which has been placed On File with the Office of Legislative Services, is hereby approved. CWA represents approximately 420 members. The proposed CWA agreement has been agreed to in collective bargaining and has been ratified by the union membership. Pursuant to the American Rescue Plan, from which funds are being used for premium pay associated with the Collectively Bargaining Agreements, the City has made a general determination that premium pay will not increase the average annual wage at the City 150 percent of the state or county's average wage. Further, the City considers all government employees at the City to be performing critical and essential functions necessary to meet the needs of the Citizens of Jacksonville. One time premium payments and wage increases collectively bargained recognize the extraordinary efforts the men and women of the City performed and continue to perform during the COVID-19 pandemic.
