5 AN ORDINANCE REZONING APPROXIMATELY 15.01± ACRES 6 LOCATED IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 3 AT 13301 BEACH 7 BOULEVARD, BETWEEN KERNAN BOULEVARD AND HODGES 8 BOULEVARD, OWNED BY EASTSIDE COMMUNITY CHURCH 9 INCORPORATED, AS DESCRIBED HEREIN, FROM PLANNED 10 UNIT DEVELOPMENT (PUD) DISTRICT (2002-791-E) TO 11 PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT (PUD) DISTRICT, AS 12 DEFINED AND CLASSIFIED UNDER THE ZONING CODE, TO 13 PERMIT MULTI-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL AND CHURCH USES, AS DESCRIBED IN THE EAST SIDE COMMUNITY CHURCH 14 15 PUD, PURSUANT TO FUTURE LAND USE MAP SERIES 16 (FLUMS) SMALL-SCALE AMENDMENT APPLICATION NUMBER 17 L-5590-21C; PROVIDING A DISCLAIMER THAT THE 18 REZONING GRANTED HEREIN SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUED 19 AS AN EXEMPTION FROM ANY OTHER APPLICABLE LAWS; 20 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Jacksonville adopted a Small-Scale Amendment to the 2030 Comprehensive Plan for the purpose of revising portions of the Future Land Use Map series (FLUMs) in order to ensure the accuracy and internal consistency of the plan, pursuant to the companion land use application L-5590-21C; and

WHEREAS, in order to ensure consistency of zoning district with the 2030 Comprehensive Plan and the adopted companion Small-Scale Amendment L-5590-21C, an application to rezone and reclassify from Planned Unit Development (PUD) District (2002-791-E) to Planned Unit Development (PUD) District was filed by Paul M. Harden, Esq., on behalf of the owner of approximately 15.01± acres of certain real property in Council District 3, as more particularly described in Section 1; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Development Department, in order to ensure consistency of this zoning district with the 2030 Comprehensive Plan, has considered the rezoning and has rendered an advisory opinion; and

8 WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has considered the application 9 and has rendered an advisory opinion; and

10 WHEREAS, the Land Use and Zoning (LUZ) Committee, after due 11 notice, held a public hearing and made its recommendation to the 12 Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, after due notice, held a public hearing, and taking into consideration the above recommendations as well as all oral and written comments received during the public hearings, the Council finds that such rezoning is consistent with the 2030 Comprehensive Plan adopted under the comprehensive planning ordinance for future development of the City of Jacksonville; and

19 WHEREAS, the Council finds that the proposed PUD does not affect 20 adversely the orderly development of the City as embodied in the 21 Zoning Code; will not affect adversely the health and safety of 22 residents in the area; will not be detrimental to the natural 23 environment or to the use or development of the adjacent properties 24 in the general neighborhood; and the proposed PUD will accomplish the 25 objectives and meet the standards of Section 656.340 (Planned Unit 26 Development) of the Zoning Code of the City of Jacksonville; now, 27 therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

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Section 1. Subject Property Location and Description. The approximately 15.01± acres are located in Council District 3, at 13301 Beach Boulevard, between Kernan Boulevard and Hodges Boulevard, as

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more particularly described in **Exhibit 1**, dated July 1, 2021, and graphically depicted in **Exhibit 2**, both of which are **attached hereto** and incorporated herein by this reference (the "Subject Property").

Section 2. Owner and Applicant Description. The Subject
Property is owned by Eastside Community Church Incorporated. The
applicant is Paul M. Harden, Esq., 1431 Riverplace Boulevard, Suite
901, Jacksonville, Florida 32207; (904) 396-5731.

8 Section 3. Property Rezoned. The Subject Property, 9 pursuant to adopted companion Small-Scale Amendment L-5590-21C, is 10 hereby rezoned and reclassified from Planned Unit Development (PUD) District (2002-791-E) to Planned Unit Development (PUD) District. 11 12 This new PUD district shall generally permit multi-family residential 13 and church uses, and is described, shown and subject to the following 14 documents, attached hereto:

16 **Exhibit 2** - Subject Property Map (prepared by P&DD).

17 **Exhibit 3** - Written Description dated August 5, 2021.

18 **Exhibit 4** - Site Plan dated March 23, 2021.

19 Section 4. Contingency. This rezoning shall not become 20 effective until 31 days after adoption of the companion Small-Scale 21 Amendment unless challenged by the state land planning agency; and further provided that if the companion Small-Scale Amendment is 22 23 challenged by the state land planning agency, this rezoning shall not 24 become effective until the state land planning agency or the 25 Administration Commission issues a final order determining the 26 companion Small-Scale Amendment is in compliance with Chapter 163, 27 Florida Statutes.

28 Section 5. Disclaimer. The rezoning granted herein 29 shall not be construed as an exemption from any other applicable 30 local, state, or federal laws, regulations, requirements, permits or 31 approvals. All other applicable local, state or federal permits or

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approvals shall be obtained before commencement of the development 1 2 or use and issuance of this rezoning is based upon acknowledgement, 3 representation and confirmation made by the applicant(s), owner(s), 4 developer(s) and/or any authorized agent(s) or designee(s) that the 5 subject business, development and/or use will be operated in strict 6 compliance with all laws. Issuance of this rezoning does not approve, 7 promote or condone any practice or act that is prohibited or 8 restricted by any federal, state or local laws.

9 Section 6. Effective Date. The enactment of this Ordinance
10 shall be deemed to constitute a quasi-judicial action of the City
11 Council and shall become effective upon signature by the Council
12 President and the Council Secretary.
