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## ORDINANCE 2021-660

ORDINANCE CLOSING AND ABANDONING AND/OR AN DISCLAIMING THE SOUTH 35 FEET OF A 50 FOOT DRAINAGE EASEMENT ESTABLISHED IN THE SUNNYDALE ACRES PLAT, RECORDED IN PLAT BOOK 22, PAGE 83 OF THE CURRENT PUBLIC RECORDS OF DUVAL COUNTY, FLORIDA, IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 4, AT THE REQUEST OF KENNETH TODD LORANT; PROVIDING FOR APPROVAL SUBJECT TO CONDITIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Closure and Abandonment. The south thirty-five (35) feet of a fifty (50) foot drainage easement established in the Sunnydale Acres Plat, recorded in Plat Book 22, Page 83 of the current public records of Duval County, Florida, located in Council District 4, a description of which is attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and incorporated herein by this reference, is hereby closed and abandoned and/or disclaimed as a drainage easement at the request of Kenneth Todd Lorant (the "Applicant"). The Applicant paid the easement closure application fee of \$1,066.00, which has been deposited into the General Fund. This closure request was reviewed and approved by the various city, state, and utility agencies that might have an interest in the drainage easement and there were no objections to the Applicant's request.

Section 2. Purpose. The Applicant owns the underlying parcel that is subject to this drainage easement (R.E. No. 165298-0000) and is requesting the closure in order to construct an addition

to the single-family home on the parcel, subject to the conditions set forth herein.

Section 3. Hold Harmless Covenant. The closure and abandonment by the City of its interests in the subject portion of the easement is contingent upon Applicant's execution and delivery to the City of a Hold Harmless Covenant, in substantially the same form attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference. Accordingly, the closure and abandonment of the portion the aforesaid drainage easement shall not be recorded in the official public records until execution and delivery to the City by the Applicant of the required Hold Harmless Covenant.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
