AN ORDINANCE APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, THAT CERTAIN SOVEREIGNTY SUBMERGED LANDS FEE WAIVED LEASE RENEWAL (BOT FILE NO. 161272789) BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE INTERNAL IMPROVEMENT TRUST FUND OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA FOR THE PURPOSE OF OPERATING A 78-SLIP PUBLIC MARINA IN CONJUNCTION WITH AN UPLAND PARK AND SPORTS COMPLEX FOR A FIVE-YEAR TERM AT NO COST TO THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT OF ACQUISITION, EXECUTION AND RECORDING OF THE LEASE BY THE REAL ESTATE DIVISION, PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, AND OVERSIGHT OF THE LEASE AND MARINA AND DOCKING FACILITY BY THE PARKS, RECREATION AND COMMUNITY SERVICES DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Renewal approved. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor and Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City, that certain Sovereignty Submerged Lands Fee Waived Lease Renewal (BOT File No. 161272789) (the "Lease") between the City of Jacksonville (the "Lessee") and the Board of Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund of the State of Florida (the "Lessor"), in substantially the same form as has been

placed **On File** with the Office of Legislative Services. The aforementioned Lease was originally authorized by Resolution 1990-375-A, and has been periodically renewed, most recently in accordance with Ordinance 2015-632-E.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the Lease is to allow for the continued operation of Metropolitan Park Marina, located at 1410 Gator Bowl Boulevard, Jacksonville, Florida (R.E. No. 130572-0100, which is an existing 78-slip public marina that offers semi-annual boat shows and other special events. The marina is to be used exclusively for the mooring of recreational vessels in conjunction with an upland park and sports complex in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Lease. The renewal term is five years beginning March 13, 2020 and continuing through March 13, 2025, at no cost to the City.

Section 3. Oversight. The Real Estate Division of the Department of Public Works shall provide initial oversight of the acquisition, execution and recording of the Lease. The Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department shall thereafter provide oversight of the Lease and the marina and docking facility.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
