A RESOLUTION HONORING AND COMMEMORATING THE LIFE
AND ACCOMPLISHMENTS OF FOOTBALL PLAYER AND COACH
LIN-J SHELL; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, a native of Orlando, Florida, Lin-J Shell graduated from Edgewater High School and was recruited to play football at Jacksonville University, where, as a defensive back, he set JU Dolphin records for interceptions and punt return yardage and was twice named to the Pioneer Football League All-Conference Team. He was inducted into the JU Athletic Hall of Fame in 2013; and

WHEREAS, after graduating from JU, Mr. Shell spent more than a decade playing professionally in the Arena League and the Canadian Football League, where he was twice named to the All-Star Team while playing with the Toronto Argonauts and earned a championship ring with the Calgary Stampeders, helping the team win the CFL's Grey Cup in 2014; and

WHEREAS, following his professional football career, Lin-J Shell returned to Jacksonville to become a high school teacher and football coach at Ribault High School, where he unexpectedly was tapped to be the interim head coach just before the start of the 2019 season, and most recently at Andrew Jackson High School; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Shell, formerly the Dean of Boys at Ribault High School, was credited with averting a potential tragedy at the school in 2018 when he witnessed a woman trespassing on the campus carrying a gun and attempting to intervene in a fight among students in the gymnasium. Mr. Shell engaged the woman, escorted her out of the

building and away from the students, and alerted a nearby school resource officer who took the woman into custody without any shots being fired; and

WHEREAS, Lin-J Shell was well known as a mentor, leader and high-energy motivator who touched the lives of hundreds of students during his relatively brief teaching and coaching career with his care, compassion, and desire to help each young person to become the best that he or she could be. His death at the age of 39 has been a tremendous shock to the community and is a great loss of a young and talented leader; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

The City Council hereby honors and commemorates the life and accomplishments of football player, coach, teacher and mentor Lin-J Shell, and extends its deepest condolences to his family and friends, to the Ribault High School community, and to all who were positively influenced by his life. His example of positivity, boundless energy, and concern for others should serve as an example to everyone to continue the good work his life represented.

This Resolution shall become Effective Date. Section 2. effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
