RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A COUNTY PUBLIC SAFETY COORDINATING COUNCIL AS REQUIRED BY SECTION 951.26, FLORIDA STATUTES; DESIGNATING THE JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE AS ADMINISTRATOR OF THE PUBLIC SAFETY COORDINATING COUNCIL AND SETTING MEMBERSHIP PER THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 951.26, FLORIDA STATUTES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 951.26, Florida Statutes, requires that each county's governing body establish a county public safety coordinating council; and

WHEREAS, Section 951.26, Florida Statutes, requires that certain members or their designees be members of the public safety coordaining council; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jacksonville wishes to establish a county public safety coordinating council and designates the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office as the agency administering and supporting the public safety coordinating council; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Jacksonville hereby establishes a public safety coordinating council pursuant to Section 951.26, Florida Statutes.

Section 2. Membership Requirements. The membership of the public safety coordinating council shall include those particular members or their designees identified in Section 951.26, Florida

Statutes. The Jacksonville Sheriff's Office is the agency designated to administer and support the public safety coordinating council.

Section 3. Effective Date. That this Resolution shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
