AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 34.203(A) (JACKSONVILLE HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION; COMMISSION MEMBERS), 2 (HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT 34 DIVISION), CHAPTER (NEIGHBORHOODS DEPARTMENT), ORDINANCE CODE, TO CLARIFY THE TERM OF THE CITY COUNCIL MEMBER APPOINTMENT TO A ONE YEAR TERM; APPOINTING COUNCIL MEMBER DEFOOR AS A MEMBER OF THE JACKSONVILLE HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION, AS A LOCALLY ELECTED OFFICIAL, PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 34, ORDINANCE CODE, AND SECTION 420.9076, FLORIDA STATUTES, FOR A FIRST TERM EXPIRING JUNE 30, 2022; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Jacksonville Housing and Community Development Commission acts as the City's affordable housing advisory committee, which is charged with recommending regulatory incentives for affordable housing under the State Housing Initiatives Partnership ("SHIP") program in accordance with Section 420.9076, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, during the 2020 legislative session, the Florida Legislature adopted House Bill 1339 to amend Section 420.9076, Florida Statutes, to require that the membership of all affordable housing advisory committees include a locally elected official from each county or municipality participating in the SHIP program; and

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Amending 34.203(a) Section 1. Section (Jacksonville Housing and Community Development Commission; Commission Members), Ordinance Code. Section 34.203(a) (Jacksonville Housing Community Development Commission; Commission Members), Part Community Development Division), (Housing Chapter 34 and (Neighborhoods Department), Ordinance Code, is hereby amended to read as follows:

CHAPTER 34. NEIGHBORHOODS DEPARTMENT

* * *

PART 2. HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DIVISION

* * *

Section 34.203. Jacksonville Housing and Community Development Commission; Commission Members.

"Jacksonville Housing and Community Development Commission,"
which shall be comprised of 11 members, all of whom shall be
residents of Duval County. Six members shall be appointed by
the Mayor and confirmed by Council, and five members shall be
appointed by the Council. Pursuant to the requirements of F.S.
\$ 420.9076, (as amended from time to time) the Commission
shall be deemed the "advisory committee" as required by state
law. The Commission membership shall consist of one current
City Council member for a one year term expiring June 30 and
one representative from at least six of the following

categories (each of whom is actively engaged in her/her respective activity): (1) residential home building industry in connection with affordable housing; (2) banking or mortgage banking industry in connection with affordable housing; (3) areas of labor in home building in connection with affordable housing; (4) advocacy for low-income persons in connection with affordable housing; (5) for-profit provider of affordable housing; (6) not-for-profit provider of affordable housing; (7) real estate professional in connection with affordable housing; (8) a representative also actively serving on the local planning agency pursuant to F.S. § 163.3174; (9) a resident within the City of Jacksonville; (10) representative of employers in Duval County; and (11) a representative of essential services personnel (as defined in the Local Housing Assistance Plan as adopted from time to time). With respect to the foregoing specific requirement in any of the above 11 activities of an affordable housing connection, if a finding is made regarding the presence of a conflict of interest or other reasonable factor that would result in an appointment not otherwise being made, then a member may nonetheless be appointed in that activity without the specific requirement of the affordable housing connection. Each member shall serve a term of four years; provided, however the initial appointments shall be as follows: four members shall serve terms of four years each, four members shall serve terms of three years each, and three members shall serve terms of two years each. Thereafter, all members appointed to the Commission shall serve terms of four years. Commencing with the effective date of this chapter, no member may serve for more than two consecutive terms. Members shall serve for the term of their respective offices until they are reappointed and confirmed,

or until their qualified successors have been appointed and confirmed, or such member resigns, whichever occurs first. The Mayor shall appoint the Chairman from the 11-member board, for a term of two years of the Commission, and the Commission members shall elect the remaining officers.

Section 2. Appointment. The Council hereby appoints Randy DeFoor, to the Jacksonville Housing and Community Development Commission, a locally elected official, in accordance with Chapter 34, Ordinance Code, and Section 420.9076, Florida Statutes, for a first term ending June 30, 2022.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
