Chapter 37 (Office of the Sheriff), Part 1 18 (Organization), Section 37.101 (Sheriff's powers and duties), Ordinance Code, is hereby amended to read as follows: 19 20 CHAPTER 37. - OFFICE OF THE SHERIFF 21 PART 1. - ORGANIZATION 22 Sec. 37.101. - Sheriff's powers and duties. 23 \* \* \* 24 To make and enter into cooperative law enforcement interagency (m) 25 agreements in connection with the Sheriff's management, 26 operation, and control of law enforcement and traffic safety 27 within the consolidated government with federal, state, district and other local agencies, in order to promote the health and 28 29 general welfare of persons in Jacksonville, Florida, without 30 further City Council authorization; provided however such 31 agreements:

1 (1) Are entered into with (i) other federal, state and local governmental agencies or local independent authorities; 2 (ii) not-for-profit corporations; or (iii) for-profit 3 entities which are providing the Sheriff's Office access, 4 5 for the purposes described herein, to certain intangible, tangible or real property owned or operated by the for-6 7 profit corporation; 8 (2) Are not entered into for the purpose of procuring goods or 9 services from for-profit entities; (31) Do not require additional funding from the City; 10 (42) Do not require the City to indemnify or hold harmless a 11 third party beyond existing statutory and common law 12 13 obligations; (53) Provide for termination at will upon 90-day notice clauses; 14 15 (64) Contain, near the signature block, reference to this subsection as the authority for the Sheriff to make and 16 execute same; 17 (75) Are reviewed and approved as to form, by the Office of 18 General Counsel; and that 19 20 (86) A fully signed and executed copy or duplicate original 21 thereof is maintained by the Office of General Counsel; and that 22 (97) The Sheriff maintains a depository, log and record of all 23 24 such agreements. 25 Section 2. Codification Instructions. The Codifier and the 26 Office of General Counsel are authorized to make all chapter and division "tables of contents" consistent with the changes set forth 27 2.8 herein. Such editorial changes and any others necessary to make the 29 Ordinance Code consistent with the intent of this legislation are 30 approved and directed herein, and the changes to the Ordinance Code 31 shall be made forthwith and when inconsistencies are discovered.
