Bill Summary: This bill amends Section 116.708 (Disposition of Auxiliary Police Officer's badges, cap and service sidearm upon leaving auxiliary service after 20 or more years), Part 7 (Miscellaneous Employee Benefit Regulations), Chapter 116 (Employee and Employee Benefits) Ordinance Code to change the language from mandatory to at the discretion of the Sheriff.

Background Information: Section 116.708 of the Municipal Code will be amended to include language to require the Sheriff's consent for auxiliary police officers and certain family members to receive the auxiliary police officer's sidearm and badge upon leaving service of 20 or more years, or upon death.

Section 116.708 (a) strikes "shall" Section 116.708 (a) adds "<u>may</u>" and "<u>at the Sheriff's discretion</u>"

Section 116.708 (b) strikes "shall" and "with the consent of the Sheriff" Section 116.708 (b) adds <u>may</u> and "at the Sheriff's discretion"
