Bill Summary: This bill amends Chapter 37 (Office of the Sheriff), Part 1 (Organization), Section 37.101

(Sheriff's powers and duties), Ordinance Code and provides codification instructions.

**Background Information:** The purpose of this legislation is to permit the Sheriff to execute cooperative agreements with non-law enforcement entities. Previously, the Sheriff could only enter into agreements with federal, state, district and other local law enforcement agencies. With this amendment, the Sheriff may enter into agreements with federal, state and local governmental agencies or local independent authorities; not-for-profit corporations; or for-profit entities which are providing the Sheriff's Office access, for the purposes described herein, to certain intangible, tangible or real property owned or operated by the for-profit corporation, without further City Council authorization. These agreements may not be entered into for the purpose of procuring goods or services from for-profit entities, or require additional funding from the City.
